DCSD STUDENT ASSESSMENT OVERVIEW

American College Testing (ACT) – Nevada requires all high school juniors to take the ACT assessment, which is typically administered in early spring. The ACT is an entrance exam used by most colleges and universities to make admissions decisions. It is a multiple-choice, pencil-and-paper test. In the state of Nevada, the ACT is used to determine High School Math and English Language Arts proficiency. The ACT is a graduation requirement in the state of Nevada. All students are required to take the test, but there is no minimum score they must achieve.

There are four sections on the ACT exam, which include English, Reading, Math, and Science. Nevada also requires a 40-minute writing test. The total assessment time for all five (5) sections is 3 hours and 35 minutes long. Each section of the ACT is scored on a 1 to 36 point scale. A student's composite ACT score is the average of your four section scores, also on a scale from 1 to 36. DCSD students receive a separate score on the Writing Test. Nevada is one of 8 states in the United States that requires all juniors to take the test with writing.

Advanced Placement (AP) Exam - AP Exams are standardized exams, given every year in May, designed to measure how well a student has mastered the content and skills of a specific AP course. Most AP courses have an end-of-year exam, but a few courses have different ways to assess what a student has learned—for example, AP Art and Design students submit a portfolio of work for scoring.

AP exams are created and scored by teams of AP teachers and college professors. Most U.S. colleges grant credit, advanced placement, or both for qualifying AP scores.

Smarter Balanced Consortium (SBAC) Assessment – The SBAC assessment is aligned to Nevada Academic Content Standards and is a summative assessment given each spring to all students in grades 3 through 8. The assessment cannot be administered until at least 66% of a school's instructional days have been completed, which is typically after the 120th day of instruction. Students are assessed in the area of English Language Arts (ELA) and Mathematics. Each SBAC Assessment has an approximate testing time of four hours.

The SBAC Summative Assessments consist of two parts: a computer adaptive test (CAT) and a performance task. The CAT adjusts the difficulty of questions throughout the assessment based on the student's response in order to identify a student's threshold of knowledge. If a student answers a question correctly, the next question will be more challenging; if a student answers incorrectly, the next question will be less challenging. Results are reported in two ways: scale scores and achievement levels. A scale score is a student's overall numerical score on the assessment. Based on their scale scores, students fall into one of four categories of performance called achievement levels.

Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) Assessment – MAP assessments are computer adaptive achievement tests in Mathematics and Reading. The assessment is a norm-referenced measure of student growth in Mathematics and Reading over time that informs instruction by being nationally normed. MAP data allows teachers to track student progress throughout a year and across school years.

The MAP assessment is required for all students in the Fall and Spring, with the Winter administration being optional. The Fall assessment gathers baseline. The Winter assessment measures progress. The Spring assessment measures the students' growth to that point. The scale used to measure a student's progress is called the RIT scale, short for Rasch Unit (Rasch unit). The RIT scale is an equal-interval scale much like inches on a yardstick. It is used to chart a student's academic growth from year to year. The RIT is not a measure of mastery or a grade, rather it provides information about what a student is ready to learn.
