A. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 6:30 PM by Chair Zibrat-Long.

D. Reports and Discussions

i. Portrait of the Graduate - First Draft

Dr. Carpenter shared the first rough draft of the Portrait of a Graduate with the school committee. After months of meeting with the Development Team, facilitators Teaching and Learning Alliance (TLA) took their findings back to the design board and have provided the graphic of the four pillars (or compass points) of the POG, along with the beginnings of marketing materials that will be used on the district website, etc to promote the Portrait. The four points are: Creative and Critical Thinker; Communicator and Leader; Engaged Citizen, and Independent and Confident Learner. Dr. Carpenter will continue to work with TLA to refine some of the graphics, materials and final version that will be brought back to committee members for an approval vote at a later date.

ii. Superintendent's 2022-2023 End-of-Cycle Report

Dr. Carpenter shared his end-of-cycle report and supporting documents with school committee members. His self-evaluation includes his overall rating on Instructional Leadership, Management and Operations, Family and Community Engagement, and Professional Culture. Dr. Carpenter also included in his evaluation one of his student learning goals, a professional practice goals and district improvement goals.

School committee members will take the evaluation form and rate his overall performance and provide their individual assessments to Meredith Henderson, who then create the summative evaluation, which will read at the next meeting on May 11, 2023.

iii. Qtr 3 Finance Report

MRSD Business Manager Michael MacMillan shared a financial report of where the district stands as of quarter three. The report included information related to annual expenditure, historic trends, expenditures by major account, maintenance of buildings/grounds/equipment, heating/utilities and substitute expenditures. School Committee members will be asked to approve budget transfers to cover significant increase in expenses related to facilities, particularly in HVAC repair. This vote will take place at the next MRSC meeting agenda on May 11, 2023.

iv. MRSD Regional Agreement - update on DESE recommendations and town meetings

Dr. Carpenter reported that DESE has come back to the district with clarity on its recommendations to the proposed changes to the Regional Agreement. The feedback focuses largely on majority voting meaning that for votes requiring a simple majority, there must be no fewer than 3.5 votes however the current regional agreement reads that one member from each of the two towns must vote in the affirmative. The could prove to be problematic with voters from Chatham as removal of this current language could favor Harwich interests over Chatham's as Harwich members have one full vote while Chatham members have a .5 vote.

A meeting of the MRSC Regional Agreement Working Group will be called for members to start working on a solution to this challenge.
