Trip Goals:

Alaska is an environment in which students will be challenged in multiple ways that will help prepare them for a world beyond SAAS:

The natural environment is rugged and wild, and students will need to practice skills in flexibility, preparedness and respect for the natural world

The cultural environment is vastly different from the urban climate of Seattle, and students will practice skills in listening, observing, and quietly respecting indigenous and rural cultures and practices

The social environment of the group will be different from the one that they are used to while at school, and students will practice skills in intercommunication, teamwork and sharing survival responsibilities (such as cooking) while traveling with a small group of peers
