Student Parking Permission Slip

In an effort to give priority to seniors, during the first full week of August student parking will be made available to qualifying seniors only on a first come first serve basis. Beginning the second full week of August student parking will be opened to juniors and continue to be open to seniors. Parking will continue on first come first serve basis to all students that qualify until all spaces fill. A waiting list created on a first come first serve basis for all applications received after the lot is full. Student must be in good standing with the Dean’s office – No major attendance issues per the attendance policy (10 days per semester from previous semester). Parking on Campus is a privilege. The **non-refundable** cost of a parking permit is \$150.00 for school year-long parking permit and \$75.00 for a semester only parking permit (Early Graduates only). To purchase, a student must have proof of the following:

1. State of Illinois Driver’s License~ No tickets will be accepted. Copy provided to school.
2. Certification of car insurance covering property damage and public liability. Copy provided to school.
3. Parent/guardian signature below.

The privilege of parking on campus may be suspended or revoked by administration for, including but not limited to, the following:

1. Leaving campus without permission or driving students who do not have permission to leave during the school day.
2. Reckless driving on school grounds.
3. Sitting/loitering in vehicle during the school day.
4. Excessive absences (excused and/or unexcused).
5. Out-of-school suspension(s).

Parking and Traffic Expectations

1. Students must park in the assigned student parking lot in assigned parking spot.
2. Parking permit hanging tag must be displayed on the rearview mirror at all times facing out so that it can be read from outside the vehicle. Misplaced hanging tags will result in a \$1 replacement fee.
3. Cars are not to be removed from school parking lot during the school day unless by authorized permission.
4. Parking permits are not transferrable to other students, including siblings.
5. Drive safely. Drive in a manner that will never endanger pedestrians or cars in the parking lot and/or around school.
6. If a student purchases a new vehicle, he/she must register the new vehicle on a new form and provide proof of insurance for the new vehicle.
7. While in the school parking lot, all vehicles may be subject to search by school officials (School Board Policy 7:140).
8. Unauthorized vehicles or those illegally parked will be towed at owner’s expense.

Parking at Round Lake Senior High School is at your own risk. Any damages incurred are not the responsibility of Round Lake Senior High School.
