



Customized Professional Learning

Teaching students who are deaf/hard of hearing (DHH) and dual-sensory impaired (DSI) requires highly specialized training. This population of students is low incidence and requires a certified Teacher of the Deaf/Hard of Hearing (ToDHH) to provide specialized instruction by way of the [Expanded Skills Standards](#). Often, districts do not have a large enough group of ToDHHs to justify the high cost of bringing in experts for this specially designed professional learning (PL) in the district. Additionally, the individual needs of the teachers change as students change from year to year and sometimes even during the year when new students are added to a caseload. You may not have time to wait for face-to-face training. Sometimes you need training **right now**. And honestly, who knows better what you need for professional learning than **YOU!**

This document provides the resources for accessing virtual professional learning specifically designed for working with students who are DHH and DSI - on **your** schedule - **right now**.

*Note: If you are seeking in-service credits toward the renewal of a Florida Educator's Certificate, it is recommended that you contact your school district's professional learning office **BEFORE** beginning a course to verify the requirements you must fulfill.*
