



#### **Overview**

Montera Sports are a part of the Oakland Athletic League (OAL) for Middle School Sports. We play particular sports in particular seasons to align with OAL and always plan to field teams in every sport. Middle school sports correlate with high school sports seasons. Most sports teams at Montera are competitive, meaning students try out for the team (occurs after school at Montera), practice twice a week, and have competitive games against other middle schools on Saturdays. In some cases, there is a club sport (such as golf) with no competitive game on Saturdays. Expect a season ending banquet to celebrate the team's season.



#### **Gender Equity- Nonbinary Students**

All students should have the opportunity to participate in athletic activities in a manner that is consistent with their gender identity, irrespective of the gender listed on a student's records. Once a nonbinary or intersex student has notified the student's school of their gender identity, the student shall be treated as either gender for purposes of eligibility for athletics and activities that are gender-segregated or gender-specific, provided that If the student has tried out or participated in athletics or an activity that is gender-specific or gender-segregated, the student may not participate during that same season on a team of the other gender.

#### **Montera Student Athlete Expectations**

#### **Student Behavioral Expectations**

- Be on time and ready to play. Positive attitude!
- Respect and support your coach, teammates, the sport, and opponents.
- Communicate absences, injuries, playing time with coach.
- May not participate in practice or play if assigned In-School Suspension (ISS) or Out-of-school Suspension (OSS).

#### **Grades/Attendance**

- Standard academic eligibility under OAL (2.0 GPA).
- OUSD requires students to be in attendance 93% of the previous semester.

#### **OAL Registration & Health Forms**

- <u>Register for OAL Middle School Sports</u> Families will have to create an account on the family ID website.
- Receive medical examination every 365 days by a licensed physician, nurse practitioner, or physician's assistant. All physicals need to be dated on or after July 1, 2023.
- Montera nurse needs a copy of doctor's form for file.
- Released by a licensed physician if absent from athletic practice for 5 or more days due to illness or injury.
- Athlete & Parent/Legal Custodian must read the Concussion Information Sheet & sign the Concussion Statement.

## Montera Athletics Registration and Requirements 2023-2024

- Complete the 2023-24 OAL Middle School Sports Participant Registration Parent Permission and Medical Eligibility forms
- 2. Register for the Envisioneers After School Program. Fee for program not applicable to Montera student-athletes

## Montera Athletics Registration and Requirements 2023-2024

3. Get a physical after July 1, 2023, from the student's physician. Alternatively student's physician complete this document.

**OAL-OUSD Physical Examination Form** 

\*\*Sports Physicals Submission:\*\*

All athletes are required to submit sports physicals completed and dated after July 1st of this year. We will only need \*\*Page 4 with the doctor's signature\*\* and \*\*Page 5 with the parents' permission slips\*\* from the physical form. These pages should be scanned or photographed clearly for submission.

**Sports Physicals Submission Deadline:** *PRIOR TO THE START OF THEIR PRACTICE.* Students without a Pre-Participation Physical will NOT be allowed to start training/practice. It is imperative that we receive the required documentation by the specified deadline to ensure that your athletes are eligible to participate in the upcoming season.
