#### **MESSAGE FROM THE PRINCIPAL**

Dear Families,

As you may know, <u>an attack over the weekend and subsequent fighting has resulted in</u> <u>the death of more than 1,500 people, including about a dozen Americans.</u> Yesterday you received a communication from our Superintendent included here for your reference, <u>Standing Together to Denounce Violence and Support the BVSD</u> <u>Community</u>.

Our thoughts are with those impacted by the conflict, including families here in Boulder Valley.

We recognize that some students may be experiencing fear and anxiety about these and other recent tragic events, and we want to assure you that we are prepared to assist anyone who needs support. Our faculty and staff will also remain mindful of our students' well-being during any school-related discussion about current events.

If your child needs to speak to someone about their concerns, please do not hesitate to reach out to your child's counselor. We also encourage you to share any concerns about your child with their counselor, teacher(s), and/or assistant principal.

#### AP Chinese and AP Japanese exam registration!



Attention Chinese and Japanese language speakers, readers, writers and listeners! If you would like to sign up for the AP Chinese or AP Japanese exam, please bring Fairview's AP and IB coordinator Chris Weber a check made out to "Fairview High School" in the amount of \$98 (or request a fee waiver). AP Chinese and AP Japanese exam registration is not on RevTrak. After Mr. Weber receives your check, the student will need to **login to the College Board/AP system** (or create an account) and enter a Join Code which will be provided by the FHS Honors Office and Mr. Weber. This step is required in order to receive the exam.

- The last day Mr. Weber will accept \$ will be Tuesday, October 31, 2023.
- AP Chinese Language and Culture will be on Thursday, May 9, 2024.
- AP Japanese Language and Culture will be on Thursday, May 16, 2024.

Both exams will be administered at the BVSD Education Center at 6500 Arapahoe Avenue in Boulder. The exams are open to all BVSD students, not just Fairview kids, so please spread the word.
