

SEVENTH AMENDMENT TO SERVICES AGREEMENT

THIS SEVENTH AMENDMENT ("Amendment") to the Services Agreement ("Agreement") is made and entered into by and between MultiCare Health System d/b/a MultiCare Behavioral Health (MHS"), a nonprofit corporation formed under the laws of the State of Washington and Puyallup School District ("District"). MHS and District are sometimes referred to in this Seventh Amendment individually as "Party" or, collectively, as the "Parties."

WHEREAS the Parties have previously entered into a Services Agreement dated September 14, 2017;

WHEREAS the Agreement was amended through mutually agreed upon amendments

WHEREAS the Parties wish to further revise the Agreement to extend the term;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the mutual benefits, promises, payments and undertakings of the Parties, it is hereby that:

SA-1 Section A-I (Term) of Exhibit A ("Services Description") the Agreement shall be revised as follows:

a. Agreement starts: September 1, 2023 ("Commencement Date")

b. Agreement ends: August 31, 2024 ("Termination Date")

SA-2 In accordance with Section 3 of the Agreement, the term is hereby extended for one (1) year, commencing September 1, 2023, and ending on August 31, 2024.

SA-3 Except as set forth in this Amendment, all terms and conditions of the Agreement, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect.
