Discussion

Food lead for breakfast with santa- Vanessa Chism will be the food lead for this event. We will get her in touch with Sue Reaver. It was decided to keep the breakfast price the same as last year: \$10 for ages 7 and up, \$5 for ages 3-5 and 3 and under for free.

The List of vendors has been sent to Barbara. We have 11 vendors signed up and paid. The price is \$15 a table.

Fall/winter spirit wear order- Lots of people are asking for sweatshirts - let's get this order in soon. It was decided to try and all add beanie hats to the order.

Gala update- The possible date for this event is April 20, 2024. Caitlin contacted the venue Brochan, which came back with the price of \$6,500 for the venue, including table and chairs but no food. The general consensus is that this is very pricey for the event. The concern is for how high the event tickets would then have to be. It was suggested to look into Thorpewood. They are a nonprofit and like to work with other nonprofits. It was also suggested that we consider having the event at MSS to save on the venue cost. This is apparently what the plan was in the year of 2020 because venue prices were getting too high. Several people expressed interest in helping to plan this event but agreed that it is such a big undertaking that we should try scheduling a separate event to plan this event. At that meeting we will discuss the budget. Tina shared that she has contacted someone who could come to the school on April 20th to do dueling pianos for the event.
