Chad's Technology Courses:



1. To begin you will need to login to the K12 members site – the link is: [K-12 Members Site - South Dakota K-12 Data Center \(k12.sd.us\)](https://www.k12.sd.us/)
2. To login to the members site you will need your username (which is your email address), and your K12 password.
(If you do not know or have your K12 password let me know and I will work with you to reset it.)
3. Once you are logged in you should see an announcement like the one below, with a link to sign in to the security training courses.


