

## **AP EXAMS INFORMATION- Alameda High School- 2023-2024**

Two things are absolutely required to take an AP EXAM in May of 2024.

1. Students must register to their AP teacher's AP Classroom using the class access code to [myap.collegeboard.org](https://myap.collegeboard.org). This must be done by Nov 14<sup>th</sup>. Any codes entered after Nov 14<sup>th</sup>, will incur an additional \$40 late charge per exam. Without the access code, you can not register on line and no exam will be ordered for you in May.
2. You must pay for the AP exam by November 8<sup>th</sup>. Any payment after November 8<sup>th</sup>, will incur an additional \$40 per exam. The College Board raised their price again this year. Each exam costs \$98. Please fill out the order form and pay cash or check to Alameda High School.

**Collection Dates-** Starting October 23<sup>rd</sup> until November 8<sup>th</sup>, Mr. Lee will be available before school starting at 8am to 8:15am, the first fifteen minutes of lunch, and fifteen minutes after school to collect payment. I will be sitting in front of the Kofman Theater to the left of the floor logo.

\*Once you register and pay for the exams, there are no refunds.

**Requesting Accommodations-** Parents and Students who wish to request accommodations on their AP exams or any College Board exams, need to apply for accommodations by January.

**Outside Students-** You must be in High School (grades 9-12) to sign up for an exam here at Alameda High School. I offer all exams on the ordering form to all students. AP Chinese is the only exception. AP Chinese is not being offered to outside students. Most exams will take place in the gym. Please do your research before signing up for the exam. If you are taking a morning exam at your school, it is unlikely you will make a 12pm exam here at AHS. No refunds will be given for poor planning on your part. We are only offering normal week 1 and 2 exams. Once you sign up on line, you can double check your registration by having your student check [myap.collegeboard.org](https://myap.collegeboard.org). No further information will come from the school. We will see you on test day in May. Students only need to show up a few minutes before the exam. Bring ID and Pencil/Pen only and sometimes an approved calculator.

Fee Waiver- There are a few ways to demonstrate the need for a fee waiver.

1. Show Mr. Lee a copy of your approved free and reduced lunch application, you got at the beginning of the school year from food services.
2. Show Mr. Lee proof of family receiving county and state subsidies
3. Demonstrate via 2022 tax return, that family income fit within the guidelines below.

### USDA Food and Nutrition Service Income Eligibility Guidelines for 2023-24

The following table lists annual family income, by family size, at 185% of the poverty level. If the student’s annual family income falls within the amount listed in the relevant row and column, that student qualifies for an AP Exam fee reduction.
