

FINANCIAL MANAGEMENTEducation Consolidation and Improvement Act (ECIA) Title I Comparability

The school district, using state and local monies, shall provide services in Title I Regular schools that, taken as a whole, are at least equivalent to services being provided in schools not receiving Title I Regular monies: PROVIDED that if all schools receive Title I Regular monies, the school district, using state and local monies, shall provide services that, taken as a whole, are equivalent among all schools.

The term "services" refers to:

1. Teachers
2. Administrators
3. Auxiliary Personnel
4. Curriculum Materials
5. Instructional Supplies
