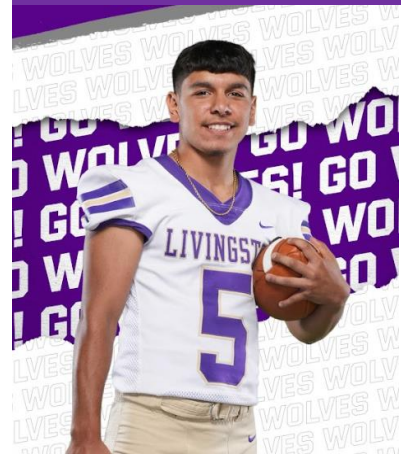

FOOTBALL



The Livingston High football program played Ripon High at home last Friday (10/13.) The Pack went into halftime tied at seven. The Wolves had to battle through adversity as midway through the fourth quarter, nursing a 7-point lead, the Pack went for it on 4th and 2 on their own 37-yard line. The Wolves' option play was blown dead by an official's inadvertent whistle; the result of the play, without the

whistle, would have been a game-clinching **Sebastian Casanova** 63-year touchdown run. Inadvertent whistles have consequences. After the officials conferenced, they decided to replay the previous down. On the replayed down, the Pack was stopped short of the yard to gain, and turned the ball over on downs. With just under 5 minutes left in the game, and the Indians having great field position, the Pack defense responded with the defensive stop of the night. Ripon turned the ball back over to the Wolves on downs. The Pack's **Alex Hernandez** (top left) ripped off a 75-yard touchdown run to seal the deal and secure the Pack's 28-14 win. **Hernandez** finished the night with 118 rushing yards. **Zach Duran** (below) added 80 yards rushing and threw a 32-yard touchdown pass to **Luis Sandoval**. **Max Nolasco** carried the ball three times for 69 yards and a touchdown. Livingston improved to 1-2 in the Trans Valley League and faces Modesto Christian this Friday (10/20) in a varsity-only contest at Modesto Christian at 7:00 pm.
