# Types of Contraband We Find

Our canines are trained to find illegal drugs -

Marijuana

Cocaine

Heroin

Fentanyl

Methamphetamine

Ecstasy

**PLUS**

Alcoholic beverages

Gunpowder

Abused Prescription Medications



# Dog Selection

- Preferred breeds are Labrador and Golden Retrievers
  - Other hunting breeds are also considered
- Must be non-aggressive to other dogs and people
- Must be well socialized in noisy/crowded public areas



# Dog Training

- Over 37 years of dog training experience
- Unique search pattern training to develop consistency in canine searches
- Canine reliability certification by third party testing organization. (CNCA) California Narcotics Canine Association



# Interquest vs. Law Enforcement

## Interquest

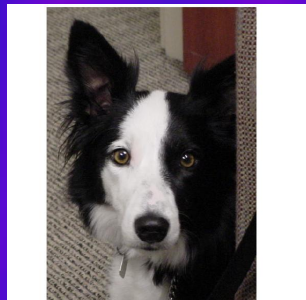
Illegal drugs, alcohol, gunpowder, medications  
Trained on grams rather than pounds  
Friendly dogs  
Non-intimidating breeds -- Labrador & Golden Retrievers  
Minimal disruption of the learning process  
Interactive with students  
Deterrence  
Higher stamina  
Reasonable suspicion  
Available upon request  
Available for service every day

## Law Enforcement

Illegal drugs only, no “legal” items included  
Trained on large quantities - pounds  
Often cross-trained and aggressive  
Usually intimidating breeds -- German Shepherds or Belgian Malinois  
Often conduct lockdowns of entire school campus  
Usually must maintain distance  
Apprehension  
Limited stamina  
Probable cause  
Infrequently available upon request  
Seldom available every day

# What we do at the school

We Inspect

Lockers (Hall and PE)

Classrooms

Common areas (restrooms, libraries, lounges, etc.),

Parking lots

An alert is identified by the dog sitting

All alerts are double checked before involving the student



# What we do at the school

Items confiscated:

scent trained contraband substances

Plus:

other types of weapons

gang related items

drug paraphernalia

All items are turned over to the school for disposition.

Interquest is not involved in the discipline process and we never question, interview or interrogate a student.



# Our dogs are friendly

Our dogs can be approached by the students

We make every effort to interact and develop a positive relationship with the students and faculty

Lockdowns are unnecessary and the normal school routine is not disrupted because we are there.





# Why the Interquest program is the future

- Time and distance
- It is as important to know that there are no drugs, alcohol and firearms as well as it is to know that there are.
- The Interquest program is designed for deterrence.
- The program provides students with an excuse to say no to drugs.
- Shows that schools are taking a proactive approach to keep the school's premises safe and secure.
