WINTER UNIFORM STARTS TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 1ST... UPDATED INFORMATION...



Beginning <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>November 1st</u>, all students in grades K-8 will be required to wear the regulation Winter School Uniform.

As a reminder, school shoes must be black, brown, or blue, and sneakers may not be worn with the regulation Winter School Uniform. All girls in grades K-8 must wear knee high socks or tights with the winter uniform.

PLEASE NOTE: If your child is cold during the school day, he or she should wear the navy long-sleeve banded bottom shirt, the navy ¼ zip performance fleece pullover, or the navy v-neck pullover sweater. The navy hooded or navy crew neck Notre Dame gym sweatshirt may only be worn with the gym uniform.

Keep in mind that we do go outside during the winter months. We check with the local weather service frequently to monitor the current temperature and wind chill, and we also walk outside to check the weather before sending students outside. During the winter months, please be sure to dress your child appropriately for outside recess (gloves, hats, scarves, etc.) and keep this in mind when getting ready for school.

Our uniform still stands as a symbol of pride and discipline for our school. Each student who wears it represents the high standard that exists because of your support and cooperation.





Listed below are some guidelines for this Dress Down Day:

Dear Notre Dame Families,

Peace and good! That is the greeting that the simple and beloved friar, St. Francis of Assisi, whose Feast Day we celebrated on October 4th, always used – but, of course, he said it in Italian: "Pax et Bene". It a very fitting and very needed greeting in light of all that is going on in our world these days. . .We certainly are in desperate need of peace – and of people who are committed to doing what is right and good. No wonder St. Francis is one of the most famous saints in the world. Even people who aren't Catholic love to hear about the patron saint of the animals and of care for God's creation.

Just as St. Francis followed God's call and spent his life in God's service, there are still men who hear God speaking in their hearts inviting them to become priests, brothers, monks and deacons. (There are also women whom God calls to follow and serve Him the way Sister Lisa does – and they become either Sisters or Nuns). If a young man thinks that God is calling him, he prays about it. . . Then, after a while, and after lots of prayer, if he still feels God's call, the young man goes to a priest he knows – or maybe a deacon – and talks about what is happening in his life and whether or not he is open to spending his life serving God. Some of the people whom God calls say "no" – kind of like that guy Jonah whose story we heard this week – and they decide to do something that THEY want to do, rather than giving their lives to God. God let's them make up their own minds. He doesn't even get mad. God knows that if people would just follow His plans for their lives, they would be a LOT happier. . .but he lets us make up our own minds.

The good news is that there are some young men who when they figure out that God has a plan for their life — and that His plan is for them to become priests — they actually do it! To become a priest you have to study a lot — and there is a special school called a seminary. Most men from our Diocese study at St. Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia. There used to be a lot of men who said "Yes" to God, so they had a big Seminary, now, from our Diocese there are only 12 or 14 who are studying to become priests (and sadly, there are even less girls who are studying to become Sisters. . .but we're not talking about the girls right now. . .). So, the Archbishop of Philadelphia decided to sell the very big building and to have the Seminarians move to another place. They are building a new house in a new place for them, which costs a lot of money. So, since some of those men are going to come to Churches here the the Diocese of Allentown, Bishop Schlert has asked all of us to donate money to help them out. . .but not only that, he is asking us to pray that more young men — maybe even someone from your family or someone you know — will decide to say "Yes" if God calls them (OR YOU) to become a priest who will love and serve God and God's people.

Here at Notre Dame, we have decided that we will pray for Vocations and we will also help. So, on Wednesday, October 25th, we are having a "Dress down Day" to benefit St. Charles Seminary. That means that we are asking you to donate \$1.00 (or more if your family would like) to this special cause. . .and if you do that, you can have a "Dress down" day on October 25th. We are actually going to have a special guest come to our school that day – it is someone who has come to visit us before, Fr. Mark Searles. Fr. Searles is the Vocation Director for the Allentown Diocese. Boys who are thinking about becoming priests usually talk to him. So, on our Dress down day, Fr. Searles is going to talk with us and pray with us. And we don't want the girls to feel left out, so Sister Lisa is going to tell us something about how to become a Sister on that day, too. 
