

Education Freedom Account Vouchers

Episcopal Collegiate School is a participating school in the Arkansas Department of Education's Education Freedom Account voucher program. Parents of students approved for an EFA voucher receive 90% of the amount of state funding per student each year.

Education Freedom Account Family Information

For the 2024/25 school year, eligible students must meet one of the following criteria.

- Students approved in the EFA voucher program for the 2023/24 school year.
- First time kindergartener
- Students who in the previous year were enrolled in an "F" rated or "D" rated school
- Students with a documented disability
- Students experiencing homelessness
- Current or former foster care students
- Children of active-duty or former military personnel or first responders

EFA voucher approval is at the discretion of the Arkansas Department of Education and is subject to funding as approved by the Arkansas legislature.

ACE Scholarships

Episcopal Collegiate School also participates in the ACE Scholarship program. This privately funded program can provide partial scholarships based on a family's financial situation.
