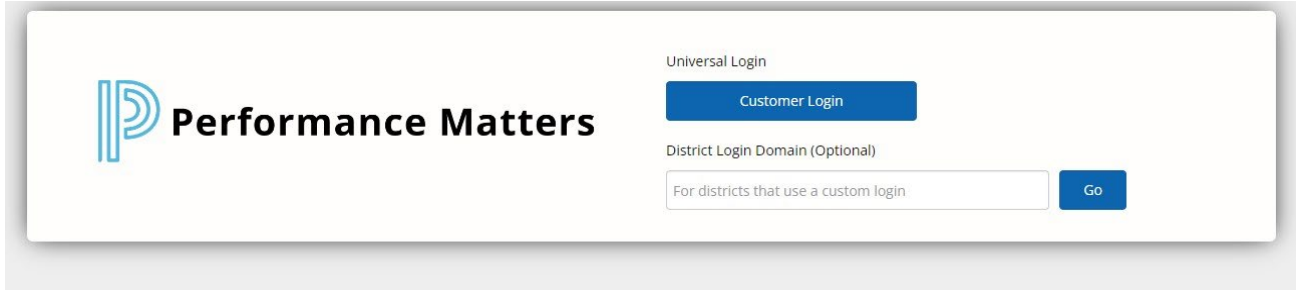


# Performance Matters Test History Portal

## Family Log In Instructions

Parents can now go into the Test History Portal to view local and state assessment results.

1. Please click this [link](#) to log in. You will see the box below. Click “Go” to get to the main login screen.

2. Once you are on the main login screen, you will see “Username” and “Password”.

**Username:** enter the guardian email address used for your PowerSchool account.

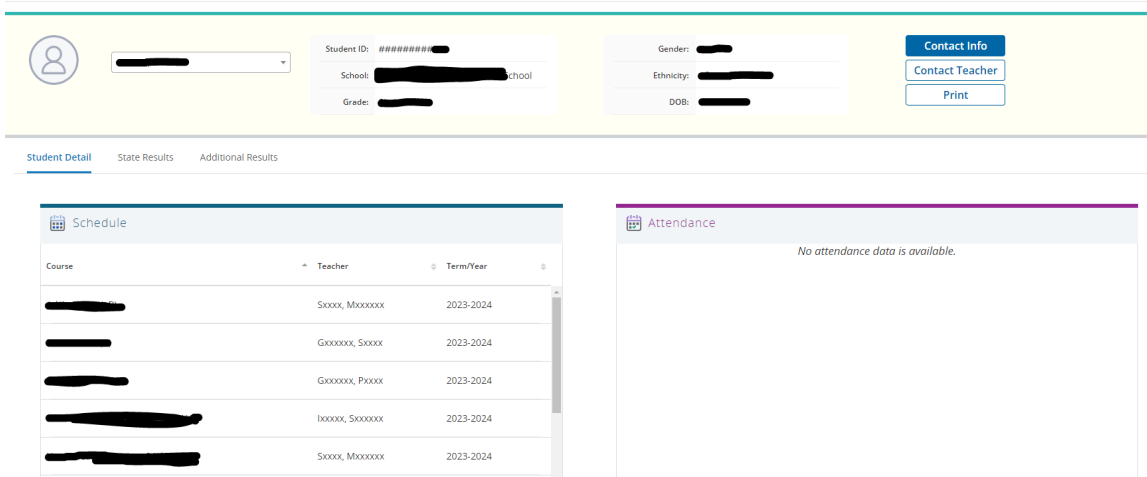
**Password:** enter your password. *Please note: if you are logging in for the first time, you will need to click on the “Need password?” option below the Login button. A link will then be sent to the email that is associated with your account. It will send a temporary password and then you will be prompted to create your own.*
