CONSTRUCTION UPDATES

In less than six months, the Greenheck Turner Community Center has gone from looking like a giant sandbox to a towering masterpiece! At first, bulldozers and dump trucks dug and shifted sand and dirt until the site was ready for the concrete footings and support beams. Now, the turf arena boasts a sleek roof and over 70 skilled tradesmen are working in harmony to bring this community center to life.

Every inch of this building is uniquely designed and relies on support of its steel, concrete, and engineering. Each steel truss weighs a massive 100,000 lbs. and takes five hours to install. The roofers are reaching new heights, scaling 71 feet to install support structures. By January, the team will finish enclosing the structure to start the interior work, including drywall, tile, carpet, and fixtures.

Get ready to cheer! By autumn of 2024, the new community building will open for business, with open arms to welcome athletes, weekend warriors, and community groups. The stylish glass entrance is the perfect spot to soak up some natural light. Inside, the walking track will be available for you and your energetic strides. The indoor turf arena can be divided into four fields with curtains, individual state-of-the-art speakers, and painted lines.

But that's not all! The meeting rooms will be complete with seating and tech to make your presentation great. Three of these rooms will have windows looking right into the ice arena! Perfect for snacking and strategizing during film reviews, board meetings, or chilling with family.

Once just a dream, this magnificent building now stands tall, a true testament to the power of a generous community. In Central Wisconsin, where spring practice is a soggy mess, this indoor turf will become a gamechanger. Every decision was made with our community in mind, and we're proud to say that the operational costs will be covered by rental rates, program fees, sponsorships, and a solid business plan.

We're on a mission to make this top-notch turf accessible to all organizations. No more cramming into a gym or sharing a patch of grass, our turf can host two or three youth teams at once, splitting the cost and spreading the fun. Plus, we're throwing open the doors for anyone to pop by for a game of kickball, soccer, or a good old-fashioned game of catch.





Sweat it out anytime, all week long, at the Fitness Center! Early birds can hit the gym from 4:30 am to 10:30 pm on weekdays, while the weekend warriors can pump iron from 6:30 am to 10:00 pm.
