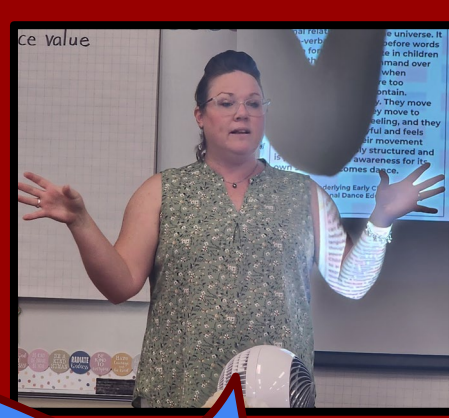


Students with disabilities experimented with creative movement at Wilson High School.

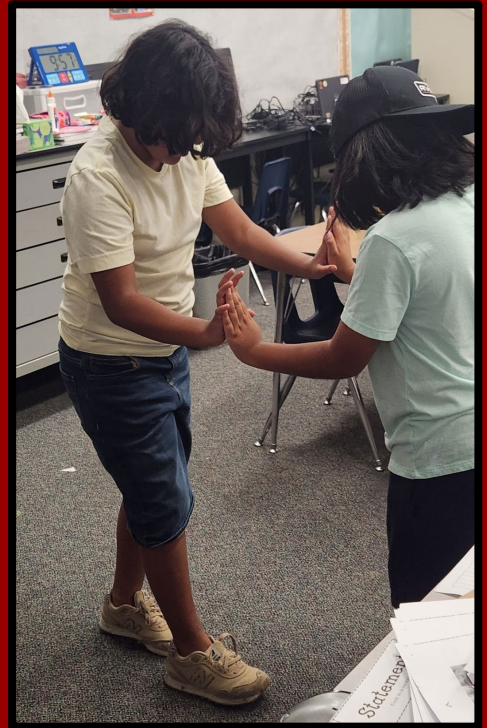


Mrs. Kraft guided students through a variety of movements to make the Isis Wings appear to fly, float, and flutter.

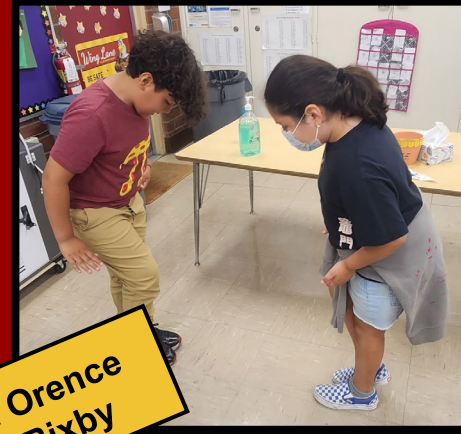
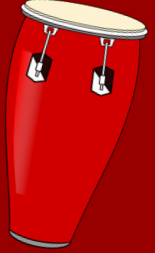
