* The **FMS** Bright Futures award will cover 100% of tuition and some fees at a State College (*like Daytona State*) for students enrolled in an associate degree program. Upon completing an associate degree, a student may use their award to pursue a baccalaureate degree and receive the standard 75% of tuition and specific fees. *However, if used directly at a State University, the FMS will fund the established standard of 75% of tuition and specific fees.*
