Top 14 Places Affected by Global Warming

VENICE, ITALY

Due to glaciers melting and sea levels rising, the places that have lower land are at risk of flooding. Sea levels rising also make Venice flood prone. It's really bad because Venice has a lot of canals and just above those canals are homes. If the levels of the canals rise, then the homes next to the canals will flood.

GLACIER NATIONAL PARK, NORTHWESTERN MONTANA

Glacier National Park is known for its glaciers, but Global Warming is responsible for melting the glaciers. The glaciers have shrunk by 85%(!) due to Global Warming.

THE DEAD SEA, ISRAEL

The Dead Sea in Israel is at risk because rising temperatures are making the water evaporate. It will become a salt flat if anything isn't done by 2050. Then the Dead Sea will be like the Salar De Uyuni salt flat in Bolivia.

ALASKA, USA

Alaska is in danger because rising temperatures can melt all of the ice and flood the mainland. Also the animals that are already living there (moose, etc..) can all die because they can't adapt to that climate quickly.

THE GULF STREAM

The Gulf Stream is a current that runs along the Mid-Atlantic Ridge. Along the stream there are eddies and meanders. Eddies are like whirlpools(underwater hurricanes) that carry hot water to the north and cold water to the south. Eddies are formed by meanders (where the current is bending), and soon the connection may snap. The eddie may go north. The Gulf Stream is affected because the freshwater from Iceland's glaciers are mixing into the Stream's saltwater, slowing down the circulation. The flow has slowed down by 15% to 20%. The Gulf Stream is our planet's cooling system. Without it, the Earth will be hot like Venus.

THE GREAT BARRIER REEF, AUSTRALIA

The Great Barrier Reef currently has coral bleaching due to rising ocean water temperatures. Coral Bleaching is when the coral turns white and then die. More than 50% of coral in the 2016-2017 period died.

THE AMAZON RAINFOREST

The Amazon has been experiencing severe drought due to Global Warming. Tree species are at risk because they need a lot of water in elevated areas. Due to droughts, the Amazon is now prone to wildfires. If a wildfire occurs, then thousands of species' habitats are going to be destroyed. The trees

of the Amazon are going to die if the dry season lasts more that 5-7 months. Currently, the season duration is just a few weeks off of that threshold.

YAMAL PENINSULA, RUSSIA

The people of this area have adapted to herding reindeer in Climate Change. Permafrost is the layer of soil that stays frozen all year in polar areas, and the permafrost is melting due to Global Warming and the weather is getting unpredictable. The winter of 2013 was very abnormal because warm temperatures led to rain and then the water froze and the reindeer couldn't dig through the ice to scavenge for food. A lot of reindeer died of starvation.

THE MALDIVES, INDIAN OCEAN

The Maldives are highly affected by Global warming because rising tides can lead to flooding homes because homes are built on islands and they're really close to the water.

THE MAINLAND UNITED STATES

Key West florida is a group of islands off the tip of Florida. In 2017, Hurricane Irma was a catastrophe to most southern states (including Key West) and almost reached Indiana!

NAPA VALLEY, CALIFORNIA

Napa Valley is known for its winemaking. Rising temperatures are disrupting the industry and Napa Valley might lose its fame soon because grapevines can't grow or sustain in such high temperatures.

THE RHONE VALLEY, FRANCE


It is also a winemaking tourist stop but rising temperatures make the grapevines' habitat inhabitable. Wine prices may rise due to this.

Pros


- They can be tamed and are very loving.

Sperm Whales Are Close to Extinction

Welcome to the world of sperm whales! Sperm whales are endangered animals so we need to help them to live. People who harpoon sperm whales are called whalers. At one time, millions of sperm whales lived in our oceans. In the 1800s, people began to hunt these magnificent creatures in a big way.

By 1900, whalers had killed three-fourths of the world's sperm whales. Early whalers hunted mostly females and calves, which were easier to find and catch than male sperm whales. With bigger and faster ships, modern whalers could catch and kill the bigger males. Scientists worry there may be too few males left for the species to survive.

Sperm whales breed slowly,producing only one calf every five years. Females must be 9 years old and males must reach 20 before they can mate.

Does all this math mean that the sperm whale's days on the planet are numbered? Some whales are called tooth whales a sperm whale is one of them. But not all whales are called tooth whales, some whales are called baleen whales. Toothed whales eat much bigger prey than baleen whales. For example, sperm whales eat squid and deep water fish. Baleen whales eat only plankton on the top of the water.

Sperm whales also have another enemy, called the giant squid: a razor sharp animal with a large beak. This squid has also caused the near extinction for sperm whales, but usually the sperm whales win the battle. A sperm whale can grow up to 58 feet long and a giant squid can grow up to 48 feet long. However, it still takes a long time to grow a sperm whale, so that's why males are quite rare.

These whales can live in every ocean in the world but in very deep places. A sperm whale weighs about 57 tons or 578,897,890lbs so that is why they eat about 9 tons of food every day.

Red Wolves and How They Survive

The red wolf lives in the southeastern region of the United States. A full grown red wolf is 45-80 lbs. The males average 60 lbs and the females 50 lbs. The red wolf eats small mammals, and some insects and berries. Red wolves were named so because of the reddish fur on their backs and ears. The red wolf also has white fur on its lips. Genetic studies say that this species is more closely related to coyotes than other wolves.

A red wolf lives in a pack with about 5-8 wolves. Red wolves need their pack to survive. A red wolf lives and travels in its pack. If a red wolf pack member gets hurt, the pack will stay with them and they will all help their one pack member to get better.

Every pack member gets food. If the pack has one sick, tired or hurt wolf, the pack cannot hunt. The entire red wolf pack uses their hunting skills together to catch larger animals such as deer. Save The Amazon Rainforest

Did you know that the Amazon rainforest is on fire? Well, it is. The Amazon is the world's largest rainforest, located in Brazil, Peru and other South American countries and it is roughly half the size of the United States.

Farmers are tearing down the Amazon to grow soybeans to import to China because it is hard to sell United States soybeans to China. This is called clogging. Tearing down the Amazon kills many species and ecosystems. People who cut down trees in the Amazon say they can't save the Amazon because they have no other jobs and they need money to support themselves.

The Amazon rainforest is burning for multiple reasons. Dry weather, wind and heat make the fires worse. In the last month there were 19,925 fire outbreaks. Scientists say there will be more fires in the future. Some farmers clear the land with fire so that they can grow crops, and to graze cattle. For the last decade, regulations have actually been reduced. These fires make leaves die and the forest canopy thins. "This is an outrage!" said Natalia Pfefferkorn, one of the authors of this article after hearing this. Because of this people are protesting to save the Amazon. It is home to millions of species, almost half of the worlds species. If the Amazon keeps burning many of those species are likely to go extinct.

Man-made fires are extremely dangerous. These are caused because of careless accidents such as bonfires left without supervision or cigarettes recklessly tossed into the rainforest. The fire outbreaks are so large now that fires can be seen from space. They are a real threat. Man-made fires can destroy entire ecosystems and kill wildlife. They release carbon and greenhouse gasses into the atmosphere. Dense smoke from fires inhabits the clouds, which actually reduces rainfall and makes the Amazon dryer. Because the Amazon is getting dryer, it is easier for fires to start and spread. In the past few months, 75% of the Amazon was affected by these man-made fires.

Scientists call the Amazon rainforest "the lungs of the planet" and this is because the Amazon produces 20% of the world's oxygen. They think this is going to be the worst year for fires since 2010.

You can help! Teach others what is happening in the Amazon. Make posters and reduce how much paper and oil you use. You can also donate to the Rainforest Action Network or to Rainforest Trust. These organizations help protect the beautiful Amazon rainforest by doing environmental programs throughout the Amazon and helping preserve the species and ecosystems throughout the Amazon. You can also donate to One Tree Planted: they help plant trees throughout the Amazon rainforest.

The population is still growing. For every 5 babies that are born only 2 people die. The place that has the fastest growing population is Nigeria in Africa. If it keeps growing at the same speed it will reach one billion people by 2100.





Before people figured it out, most families thought it was the sewers that made the tree smell. Other families had many other thoughts involving the white sap all over the base of the tree.



The Hyperloop Train



The hyperloop train's speed can go up to 760 mph. The hyperloop is faster than an airplane's speed and other trains' speed. In 2013, when the hyperloop train was made, it cost \$6 billion or \$11.5 million per mile. Other companies have owned the hyperloop but right now Tesla owns the hyperloop.

It is easily the fastest train or vehicle on earth, but a rocket ship is way faster. The hyperloop travels with magnet levitation in solid tubes which are located with emergency exits every few feet. It has no windows because it is so fast you would not be able to see anything. Elon Musk created the first hyperloop. The hyperloop construction cost now is between \$9 and \$13 billion dollars. The hyperloop is going to be built to be super safe and that is Tesla's number one priority.

There are universities testing the hyperloop which are University of Politecnica de Valencia, The University of Colorado in Denver, The University of California in Irvine. Also, testing is being done at The University of Cincinnati and The University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign.

If you are looking to see how long it takes to build a hyperloop? It takes about 20 years to build an official hyperloop. The hyperloop does not use steam or diesel for the motor. It uses an electric motor instead.

About Humane Mouse Traps:




About How Smart A Mouse Is:
