
Boundary Lines




Proposed Elementary Boundaries Map


SCENARIO A 2.0

TWI Lesson with Ms. Barroso

- TWI classes are composed of approximately 50% of students who qualify for bilingual education services and the other 50% are students who speak a non-Spanish language at home.
- In our commitment to equity we proactively seek out all races to be part of the Dual Language program.
- We also welcome multilingual students into our program.



TWI DATA

How Was TWI Developed?



Public schools are required by State law to provide English language learning (ELL) programs and supports when 20 or more English language learners of the same language are in a school (ISBE State code Section 228.25 Program Options, Placement, and Assessment).

The TWI program exists first and foremost to serve Spanish-speaking students

- Transitional Bilingual Education (TBE) Programs weren't servicing emergent bilingual students well in D65
 - D65 educators pushed for the TWI program because TBE programs are a 'subtractive' model vs. TWI which is an 'additive' model
- 2001/02 - TWI began in D65 at 1 schools (Washington)
- TWI expanded to 4 more schools (Dawes, Oakton, Washington, Willard, Dewey)
- 2018 - Rhodes TWI Transition began with the Fall 2018 Kindergarten class






