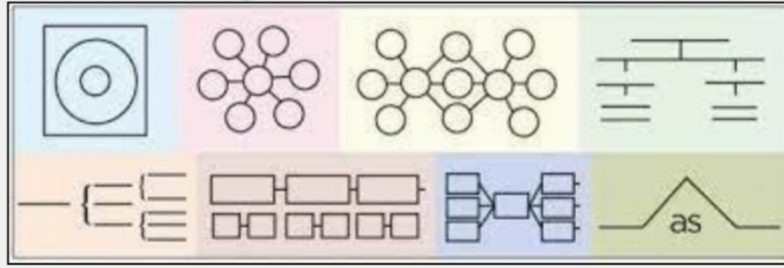
Turning pages, earning trophies
