The College Board recognizes Union Catholic's Advanced Placement (AP) courses as college-level courses. In addition, the courses listed on the following pages have been approved as college-level courses for dual credit.

What is dual enrollment?

Dual enrollment refers to students being enrolled in a course for both high school credit and college credit. Enrollment in these courses is open to all students meeting the prerequisite; the dual credit component is optional and involves an additional fee which represents a significant savings over college credits.

Students meeting eligibility requirements have an opportunity to earn the equivalent of a full year of college credits while enrolled in high school.

Colleges and Universities have varying policies on the acceptance of dual credit. Students must check with the institutions they are interested in applying to regarding the acceptance of these credits.
