

YOUR FAFSA CHECKLIST



Students interested in enrolling Fall 2024 should complete the 2024-2025 FAFSA available in December 2023.

What information do I need to complete the FAFSA?

- 2022 income tax returns for students and parents
- 2022 W-2 forms for students and parents
- Bank statements for students and parents
- Asset statements for students and parents: studentaid.gov/help/asset-net-worth
- FSA ID (see below for more information)
- Marital status of parents; if applicable, date of separation: studentaid.gov/2324/help/marital-status

What is a Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID?

Your FSA ID allows you to access Federal Student Aid websites and can serve as your legal signature. Learn more: studentaid.gov/help/fsa-id

Who needs to create an FSA ID?

Biological or adoptive parents and/or stepparents.

When do I need to use my FSA ID?

When logging in to any U.S. Department of Education website, like fafsa.gov, StudentLoans.gov, and StudentAid.gov.

What information do I need to create an FSA ID?

- Full legal name
- Email address (if you do not have an email address, you will need to create one)
- Date of birth
- Social Security number
- Contact information (current home address)
- If applicable: old FAFSA PIN
