Violence Free Initiatives:

- BJHS provides a safe and structured environment that is free of violence.
 - We achieve this by taking a proactive approach to build relationships with students and parents from the beginning to the end of the school year.
 - We utilize Restorative Practices in order to teach students how to resolve conflict in a healthy manner.
 - We provide support services to students from our school counselor and district Communities in Schools Specialist.
 - We employ enhanced security protocols including lockdown procedures, fire drills, and safety devices, high tech surveillance inside and outside of the campus, automatic locks, buzzers, and intercoms.

Drug Free Initiatives:

- BJHS provides a drug free and structured environment.
 - We actively participate in “Red Ribbon Week”.
 - We engage in Restorative Practices circles discussing the negative impact of recreational drug use.
 - We conduct routine searches by the drug dog units as advised by the district.
 - We consider alternative discipline placements for students who violate campus and district policies related to drugs.
