The Rogers Board of Education recognizes that among those rights retained by the people under our constitutional form of government is the freedom to govern one's personal appearance. When, however, dress and grooming substantially disrupt the learning process for the individual student other students, or the learning climate of the school, it becomes a matter subject to disciplinary action.

A student's appearance or mode of dress or cleanliness will not be permitted to disrupt the educational process or constitute a threat to health or safety. When, in the judgment of a principal, a student's appearance or mode of dress disrupts the educational process, or constitutes a threat to health or safety, the student will be required to make modifications.

Students are prohibited from wearing, while on school property during the regular school day or at school sponsored activities and events, clothing that exposes the underwear or buttocks, or the breast of a female. This does not apply to a costume or uniform worn by a student participating in a school sponsored activity or event.
