



Simi Valley High School Boy's Locker Room Project

AGREEMENT R24-01341

This Project Assignment Amendment ("PAA") is entered by and between Simi Valley Unified School District and Knowland Construction Services, Inc. ("Inspector Firm") as of July 1, 2023.

WHEREAS, the District and Inspector Frim entered into a written Agreement entitled Agreement No. A22.088 for On-Going Project Inspector Services ("Agreement") generally establishing terms and conditions for the Project Inspector's inspection services for Projects assigned by the District to the Inspector Firm for completion of Project Inspector Services.

WHEREAS, this PAA sets forth the specific terms and conditions applicable to the Assigned Project and the Project Inspector Services to be completed by the Inspector Firm for the Assigned Project.

NOW THEREFORE, the District and Project Inspector agree as follows:

- 1. <u>Assigned Project Description</u>. The Assigned Project is described as follows: Provision of an Inspector for the Simi Valley High School Boy's Locker Room Project. The Inspector shall be assigned by Knowland Construction Services, Inc. to the project for the duration of the Simi Valley High School Boy's Locker Room Project, unless another inspector is requested by the District. The inspector is to remain consistent throughout the project and cannot be replaced without approval from the District.
- 2. <u>Project Inspector Services for Assigned Project</u>. The Inspector Firm shall complete all Project Inspector Services for the Assigned Project set forth in the Agreement, including but not limited to: Preconstruction services, Phases Schematic through Project Closeout.
- 3. <u>Project Inspector</u>. The Inspector Firm designates one of the following the Project Inspectors: Dan Alberico or Wayne Quire, for completion of Project Inspector Services for the Assigned Project. The Inspectors cannot be interchanged. The Inspector assigned will remain through the duration of the project. The Project Inspector must pass DOJ fingerprinting requirements identified in California Education Code Section 45125.1. The hourly billing rate for the Project Inspector designated for the Assigned Project is set forth in Attachment 1 to this PAA and is not subject to adjustment, and includes all projected costs related to AB-5, which became effective beginning on January 1, 2020. Royal High School Project:

On August 17, 2021, the Board adopted the procedures and guidelines for the award of lease-leaseback (LLB) contracts. On November 30, 2021, a Request for Proposals was issued seeking preconstruction and lease-leaseback services for the Royal High School Modernization Projects. The RFP set forth the criteria, based on qualifications and price, and the method in which the proposals were to be evaluated. The District received four proposals and, after scoring the proposals and interviewing the firms, Balfour Beatty Construction, LLC received the highest score, and is therefore the best value to the District. On January 18, 2022 the Board of Education approved Balfour Beatty Construction, LLC as the Lease Leaseback (LLB) Contractor for the projects at Royal High School and amended the approval on March 14, 2023 to incorporate the Simi Valley High School MPR / Kitchen / Classroom Bldg.

The District requested a GMP proposal, for equipment procurement, from Balfour Beatty Construction, LLC, for the following project:

The Kitchen Modernization Project, Phase I at Simi Valley High School, Consent #13

After reviewing and negotiating the proposal, the proposal was deemed complete and qualified, and therefore the best value to the District.

On May 17, 2022, the Board of Education approved the Nazerian Group as a Lease Leaseback (LLB) Contractor for various projects throughout the District. The Nazerian Group will be providing materials and installation for the Royal HS MPR Audio Package, as the LLB Contractor.

The District requested a GMP proposal, from the Nazerian Group, for the Royal MPR Audio Package, Consent #26
