ACADEMIC INFORMATION

Preschool

We follow the Montessori method, which involves grouping children of different ages in the same classroom. Each child works with material according to his/her age and unique characteristics, carefully supervised by a guide. The child learns at his/her own pace under an individual learning plan.

Elementary School

We follow a constructivist educational model, which is a method that is based on the idea that children actively construct and develop their own knowledge through curiosity, research, and collaborative work. Additionally, our whole elementary program is led by the IPC (International Primary Curriculum). This program is a comprehensive, thematic, creative curriculum with a clear process of learning and with specific set goals for international mindedness. We also use the Cambridge University curriculum, which is based on drawing students' attention to global topics in order to help them develop critical thinking skills and a passion for learning as a basis for our study plan. This provides our students with a solid academic foundation that they can build upon as their education continues.



Middle School

We have a very robust curriculum which includes the academic aspect, as well as the socio-emotional education that all students need, particularly at this age. We have an integrated STEM approach based on the idea of educating students in four specific disciplines in an interdisciplinary manner: science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.

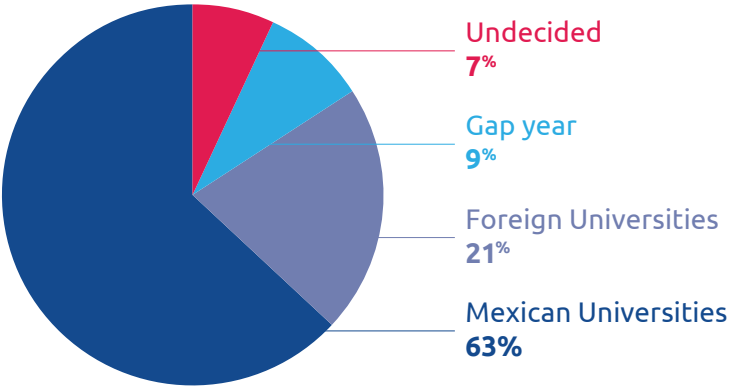
The MS curriculum is also led by the University of Cambridge's Lower Secondary program, which focuses on mathematics, English, science and global perspective. By pursuing this program, students receive a broad and balanced education for their future educational performance, work and life. This program prepares students for the IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education).



High School

Our students follow the IGCSE program, under the University of Cambridge, during grades 9 and 10, which allows them the option to choose from a wide variety of courses. Then, in grades 11 and 12 students undertake the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Programme; a curriculum made up of college-level courses within six subject groups.

Seniors College Placement for 2023

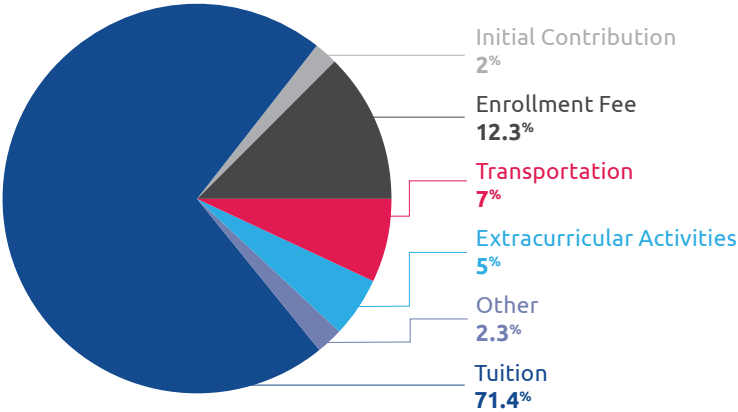


Income and Expenses

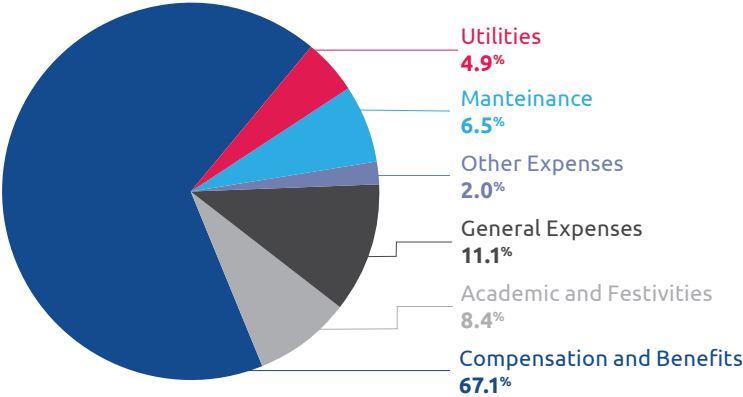
Peterson Schools receives income from tuition and registration, bus service, summer camp, and extracurricular activities, among others. This income goes into a general fund, which supports the school wide operations, such as, compensation and fringe benefits, school materials, school transportation, etc.

Other income includes the enrollment fee, which is used for capital investments principally in buildings and ground improvements, and donations, which are used mainly for scholarships.
