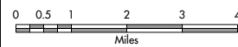
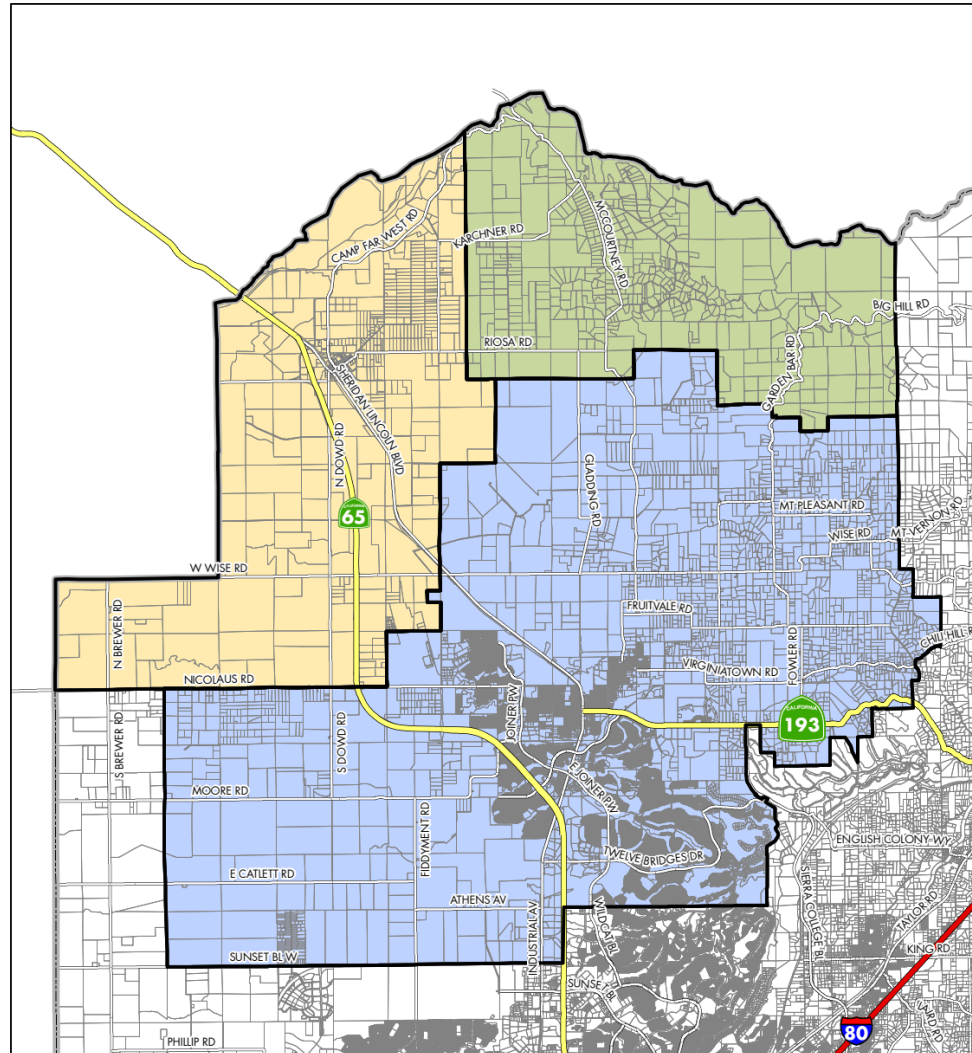

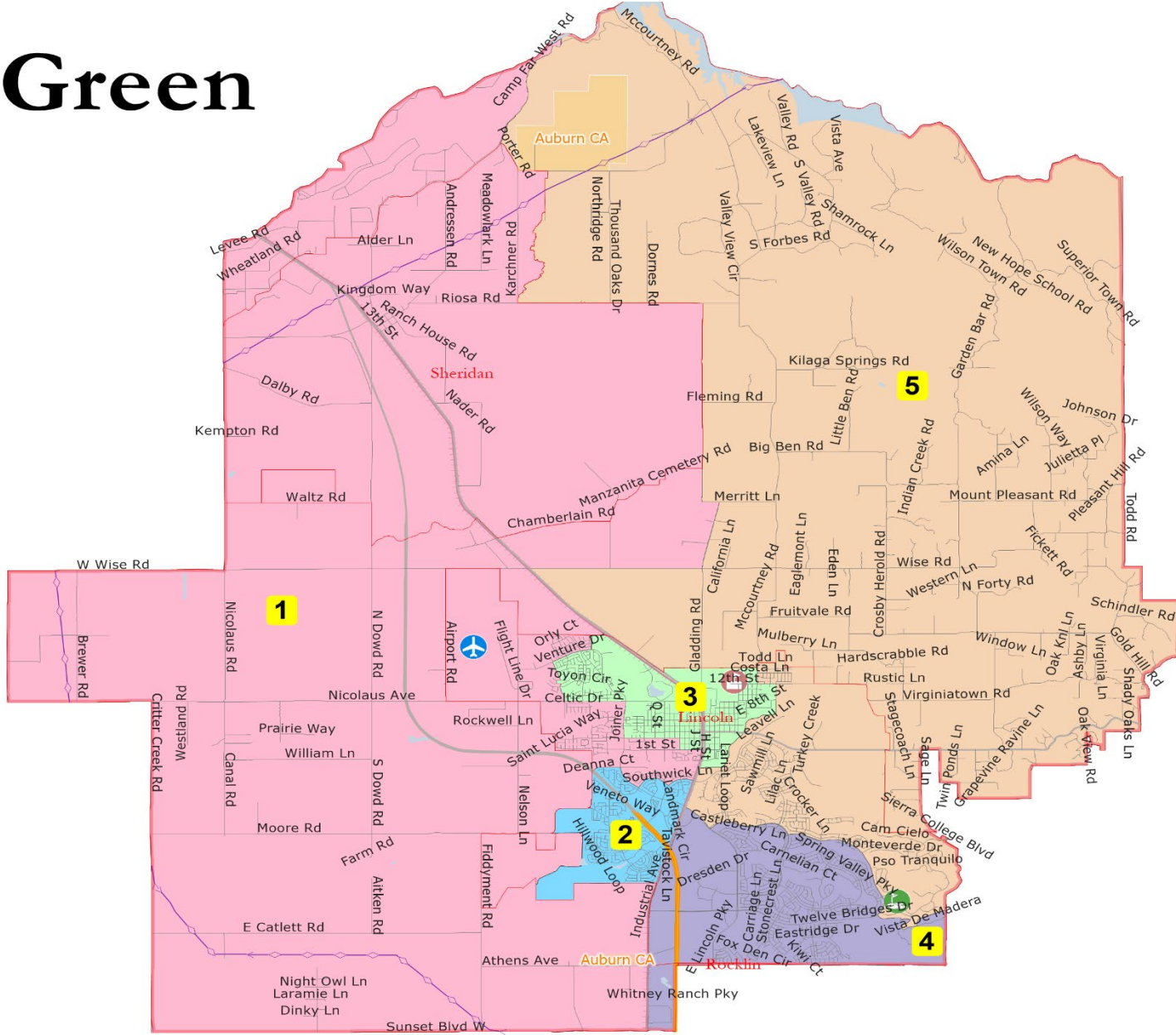
Demographic Profile

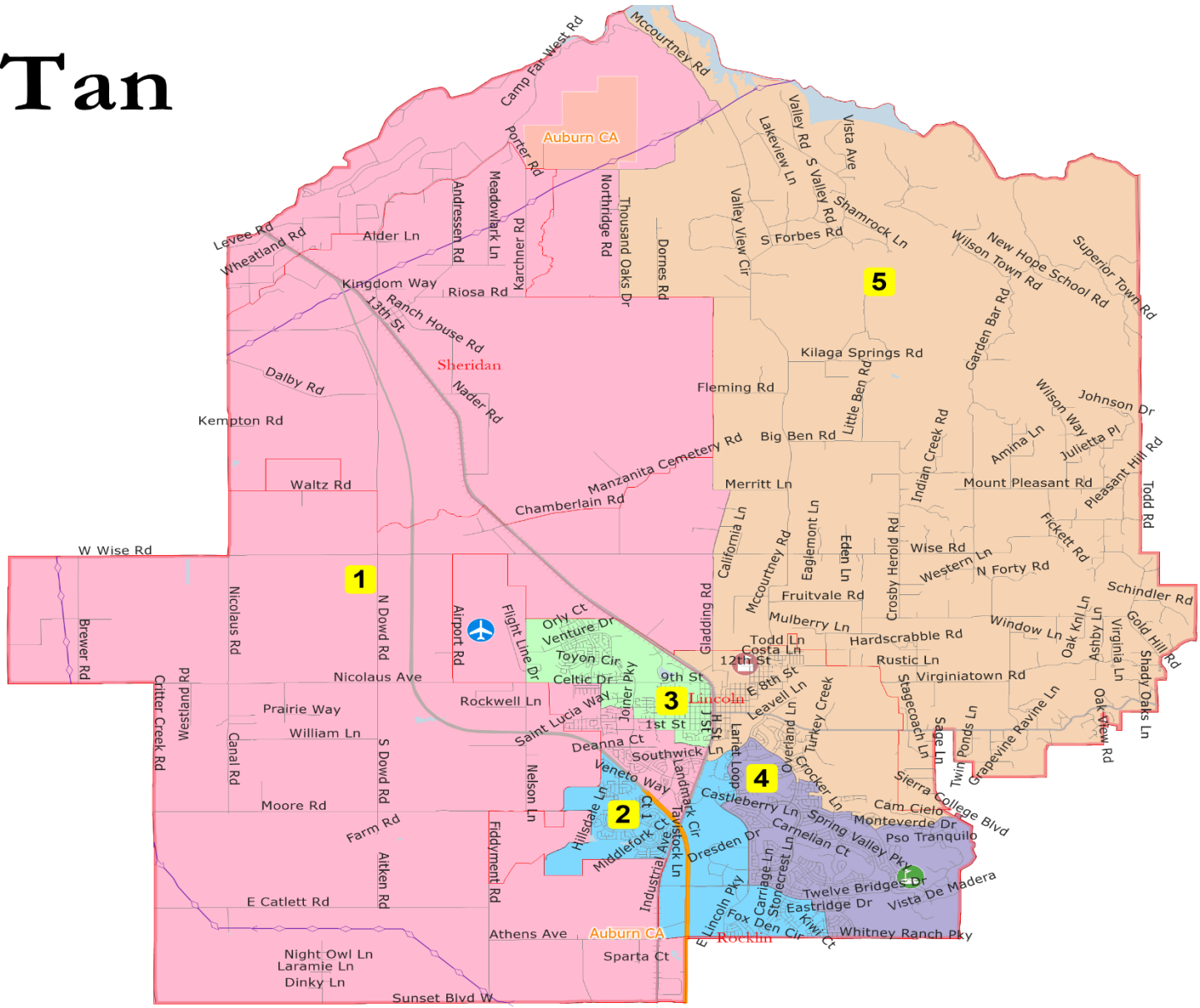

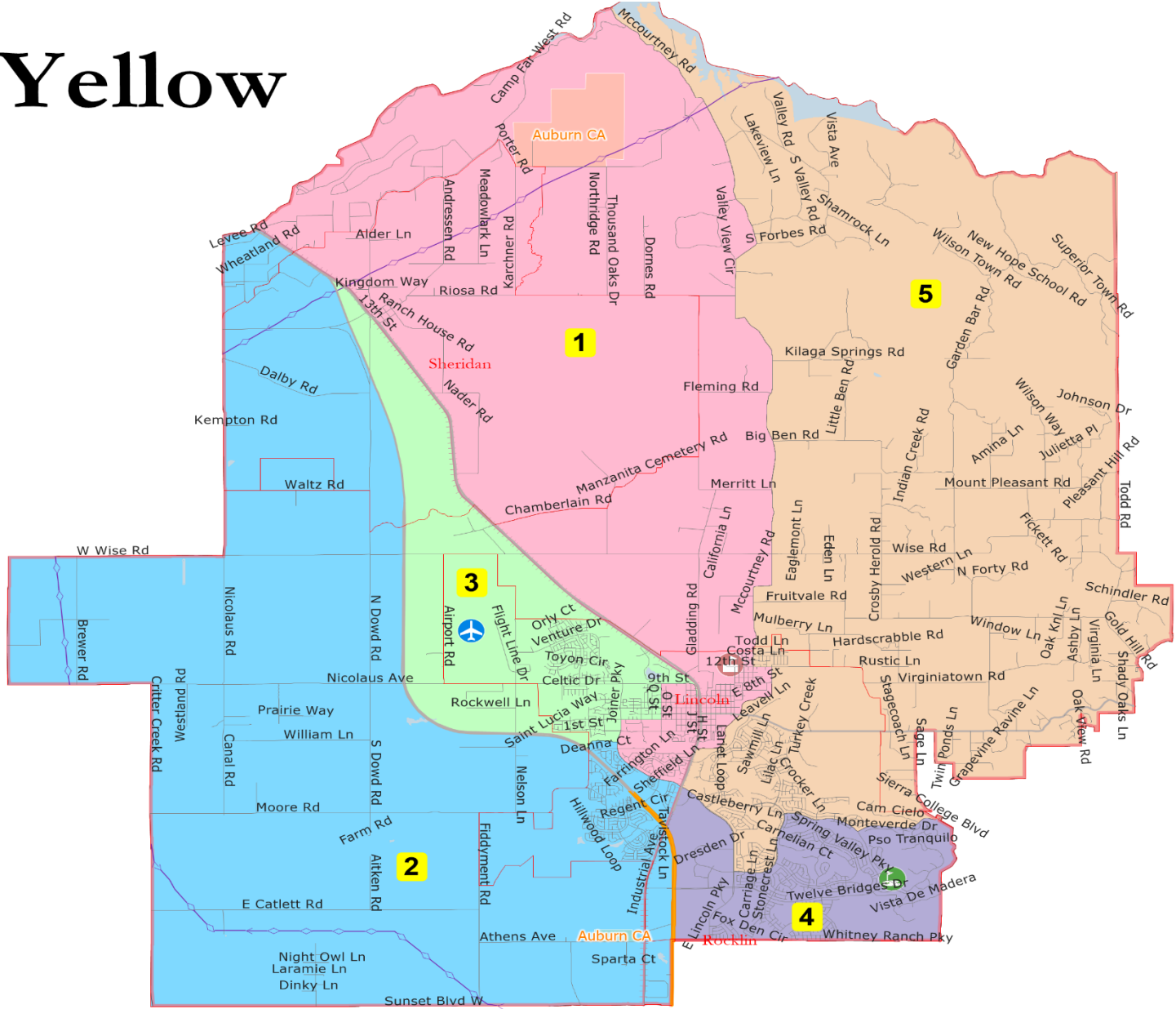

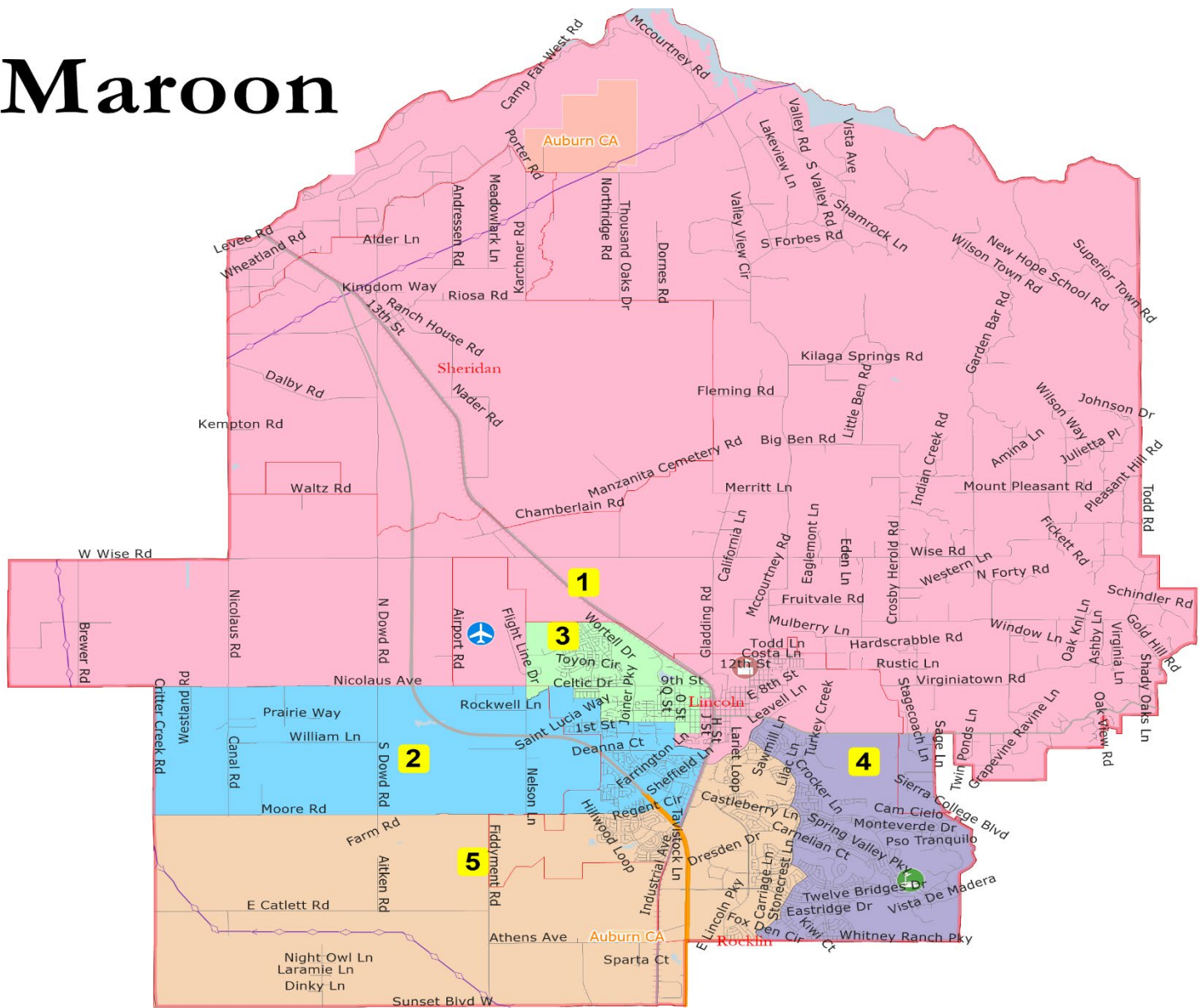
