Dr. Saenz states he assists La Joya school district by prescribing EpiPen and signing standing orders. Narcan has been approved to be sold over the counter. Recommends each police office and campus nurse have one. States many different drugs are being laced with fentanyl, very dangerous, one pill can kill you. Cameron county has had 2 deaths related to fentanyl.
