Lottery Overview

The lottery is a blind, computer-generated process conducted by the Director of Accelerated Programs, Choice, and Innovation for the Lake Washington School District. The lottery selection was conducted on Friday, January 5, 2024 with witnesses present at the Lake Washington School District Resource Center. Notification of a student's lottery number will be sent via email from the Lake Washington School District.

Lottery and Wait List Process

- 1) Candidates are placed in The Cambridge AICE Program at Juanita High School by lottery order until all vacancies are filled. There is room for 60 students for the Class of 2028.
- 2) Once enrollment is met, remaining students are placed on the wait list in lottery order. Students are not issued a new number and no additional lottery is run.
- 3) Once a student transfers out of the program or declines enrollment, the wait list of the current year is activated.
- 4) Students are contacted via email in **lottery order only** using the original lottery number as **no new lottery numbers** are generated.
- 5) Once a waitlist student is contacted via email, the deadline for acceptance will be included in the email. Students will be given at least 24 hours to respond.
- 6) **Once a student accepts placement in The Cambridge Program at Juanita High School, his or her name is removed from all other wait lists.**
