Pick-Up/Drop Off

Parents are **ONLY ALLOWED** in the Main Office. Primary Students (K-2) should be dropped off at Door #5 between 7:50 am and 8:05 am. Students will be greeted by staff members daily and given direction to their classrooms.

Any student arriving after 8:05 am must enter the building through the Main Office (Door #1). Kindergarten students should be dropped off at door #5 and picked up in the cafeteria and signed out by a parent.

Our free breakfast & lunch program have began. Students will get free breakfast before 8:05am. Lunch time will be 10:30-10:55am for Kindergarten and 11:00-11:25am for primary. Please make sure you are bringing your students to school **ON TIME** that way they are giving the proper amount of time to eat breakfast if they didn't at home. Learning will start promptly at 8:05am any student arriving after that time will be marked tardy.

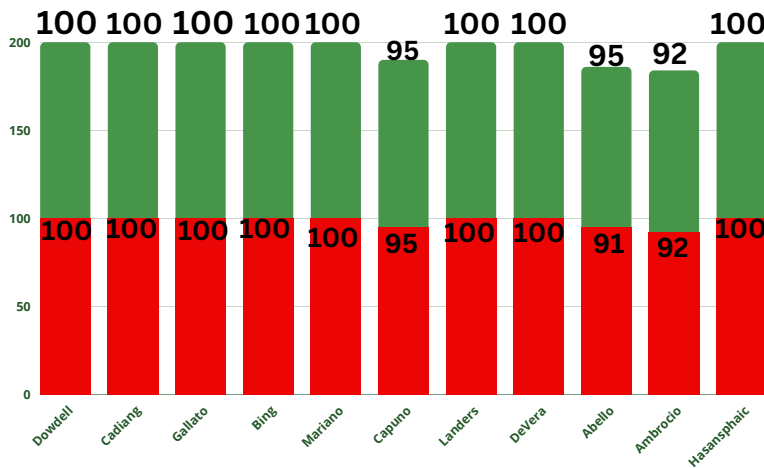

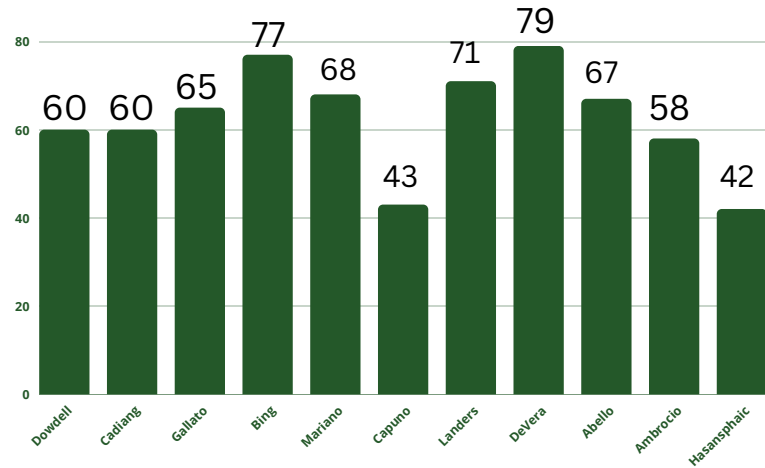
