#### SCHOOL

Established in 1982, Community School of Naples (CSN) is the largest independent, nonsectarian school in Southwest Florida. The Upper School was established in 1992 and graduated its first senior class in 1996. One hundred percent of seniors attend selective four-year colleges.

#### **STUDENT BODY**

MISSION STATEMENT

CSN students represent diverse economic and social backgrounds, and 16.8% of the student body receives tuition assistance. Total tuition assistance is \$4,161,060. The student body includes students from 22 countries outside of the United States, and students with diverse backgrounds comprise 18% of Upper School enrollment. The total enrollment of CSN for 2025-2026 is 1046, including:

- Upper School (grades 9-12): 411 students.
- Middle School (grades 6-8): 242 students.
- Lower School (grades PK-5): 393 students.

#### FACILITY

The faculty is comprised of 128 teachers and administrators who also teach. Of the 50 members of the Upper School faculty and leadership, 78% hold advanced degrees. The average student/faculty ratio is 8:1 (Upper School).

#### NOTEWORTHY OPPORTUNITIES AT CSN

- <u>CSN Scholars Program</u> enables students to specialize in one of four areas: Creative, Human Performance, Global, and STEM. Students who successfully complete all requirements of this program receive special designation on their transcripts.
- AP Capstone Diploma Program is a rigorous program designed to equip students with critical thinking, research, and communication skills, and involves taking AP Seminar and AP Research as well as four additional AP Exams of their choosing.
- <u>Junior Experience</u> is a two-week program at the end of junior year. During this time, students complete an outdoor education trip, where they hone skills of leadership, compassion, and self-reliance. Students also participate in Career Bound (job shadowing in a student's possible profession) and College Bound (a workshop focusing on the Common App, college essay, and one-on-one meetings with a College Counselor).
- The Juliet Collier Sproul Center for Community & Global Impact seeks to create transformational opportunities for students to contribute meaningfully to the community, the environment, and the world beyond through purposeful acts of service.
- <u>Cum Laude Society & Honor Societies:</u> honor students scholastic achievement. The top 20% of the senior class is inducted into The Cum Laude Society. Students have the opportunity to be invited to academic honor societies (12) in their junior and/or senior year.

Community School of Naples has a robust and competitive athletic program of 14 sports, which are supported by 40 different teams. Over 70% of Upper School students participate in athletics on campus.


### ADVANCED PLACEMENT: May 2025

Of the Class of 2026, 100% of CSN students will have taken at least one AP course at Community School of Naples. In May 2025, 294 students took 830 Advanced Placement Exams. Twenty-two (22) students in the Class of 2026 earned the AP Capstone Diploma in 24-25.

CSN has an open enrollment policy for most AP courses. Students enrolled in an AP course must take the AP Exam in order to receive AP credit and weighting on their transcript.
