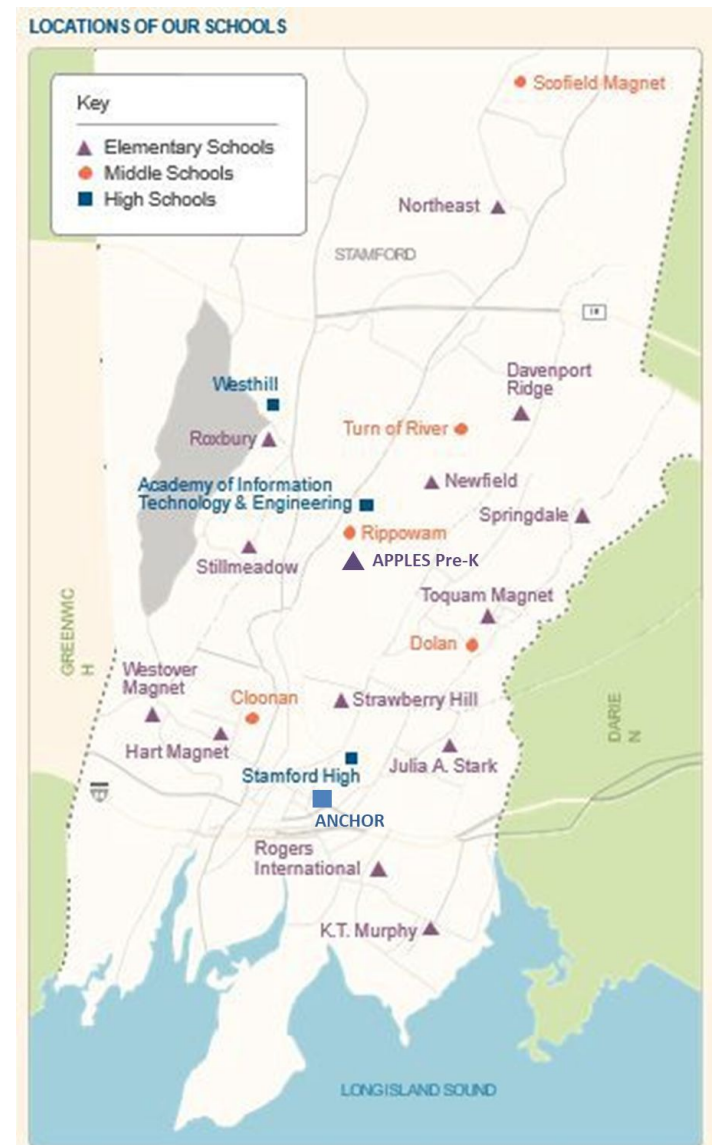

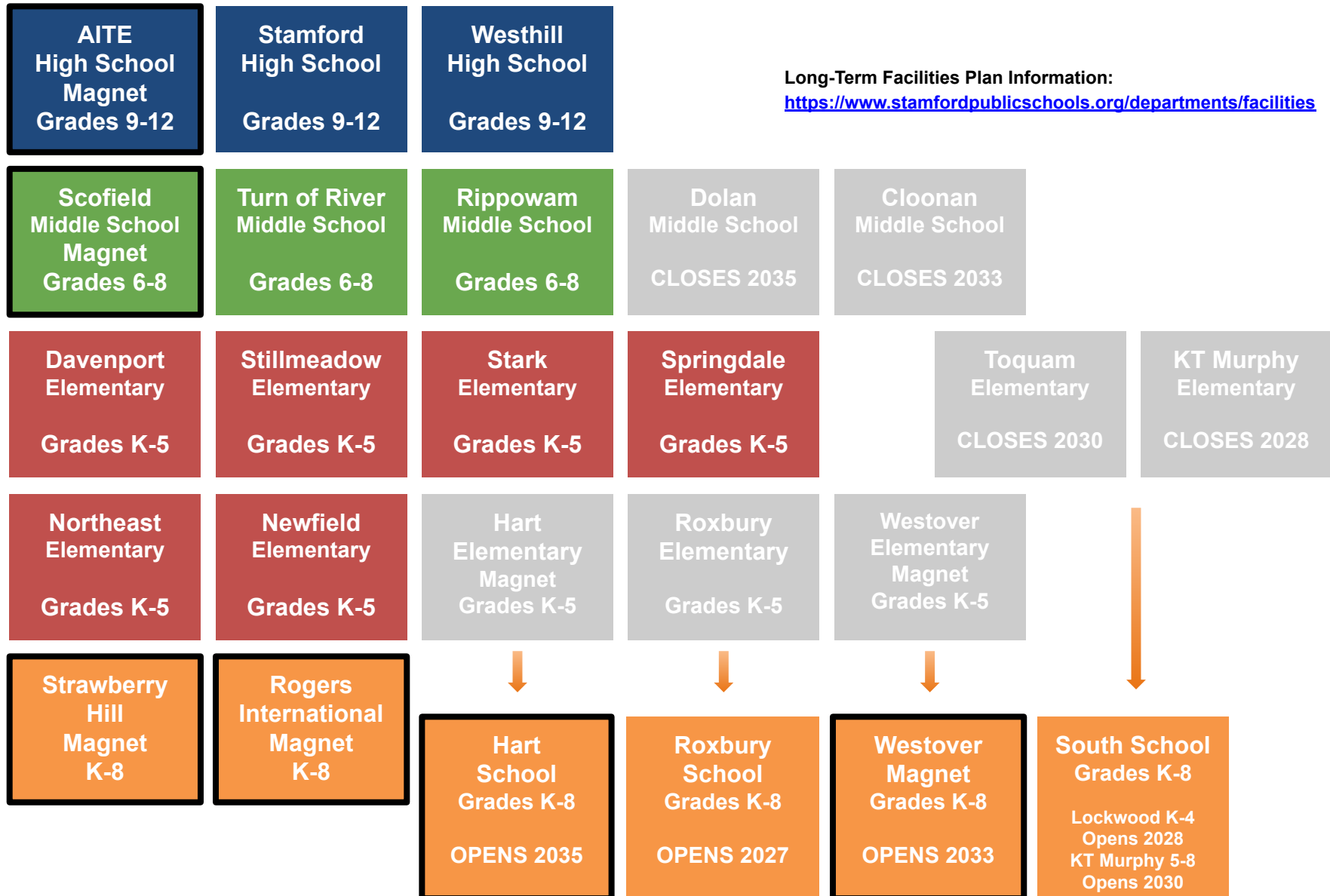

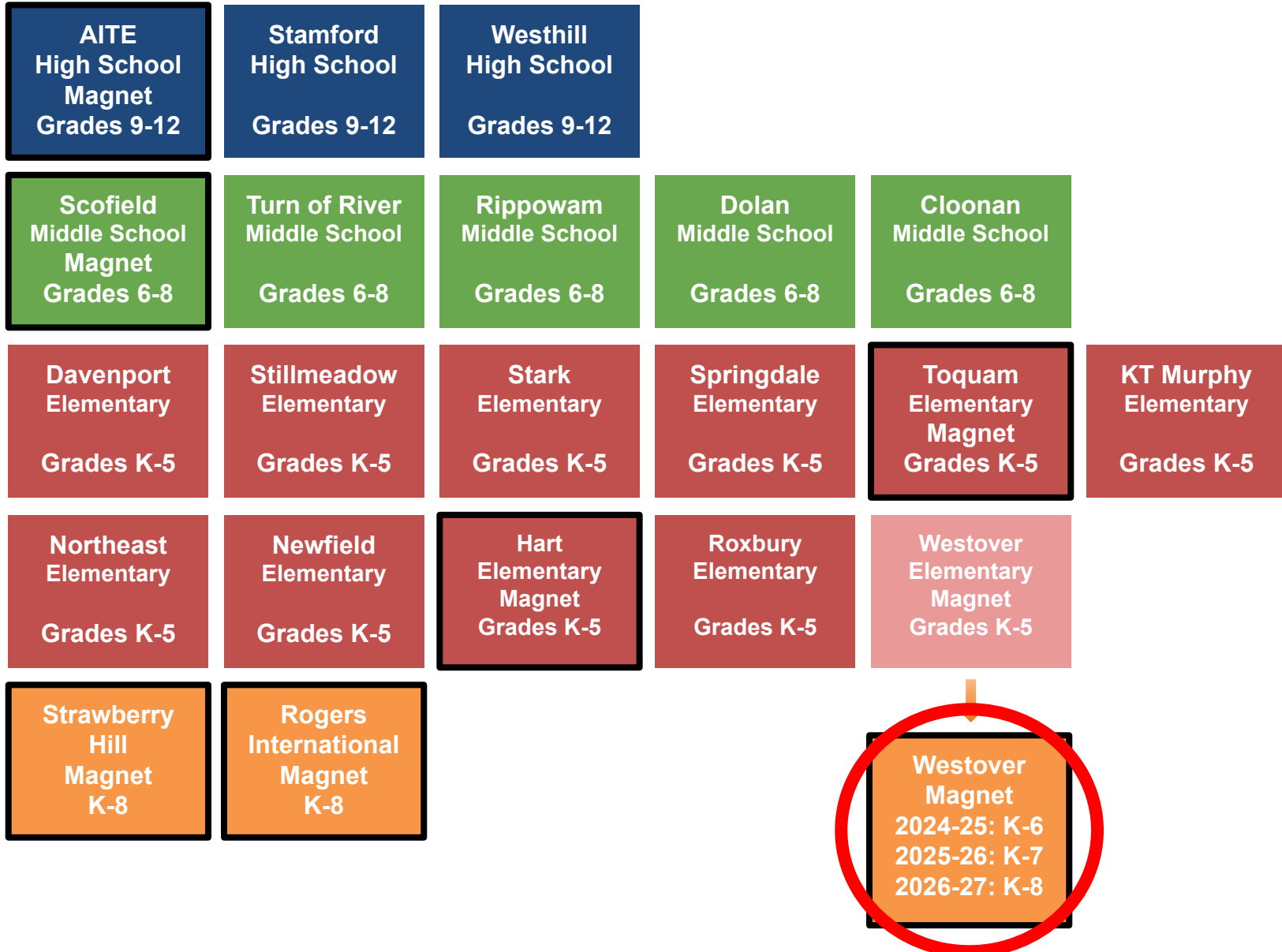

- School will remain intra-district magnet with zoned attendance area
- All students (zoned and magnet) will remain through grade 8
- Westover 6-8 can open nine years ahead of schedule

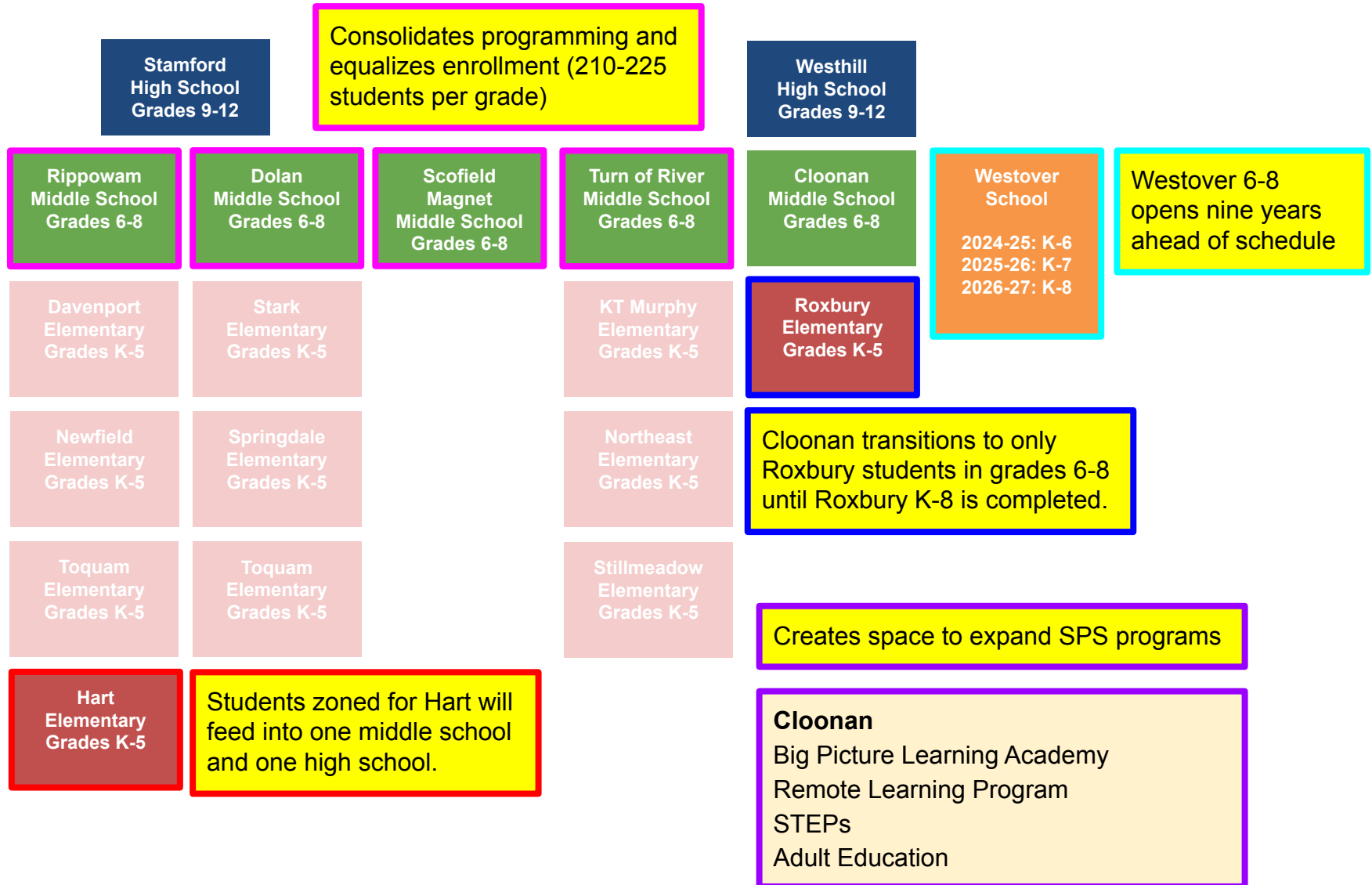
