

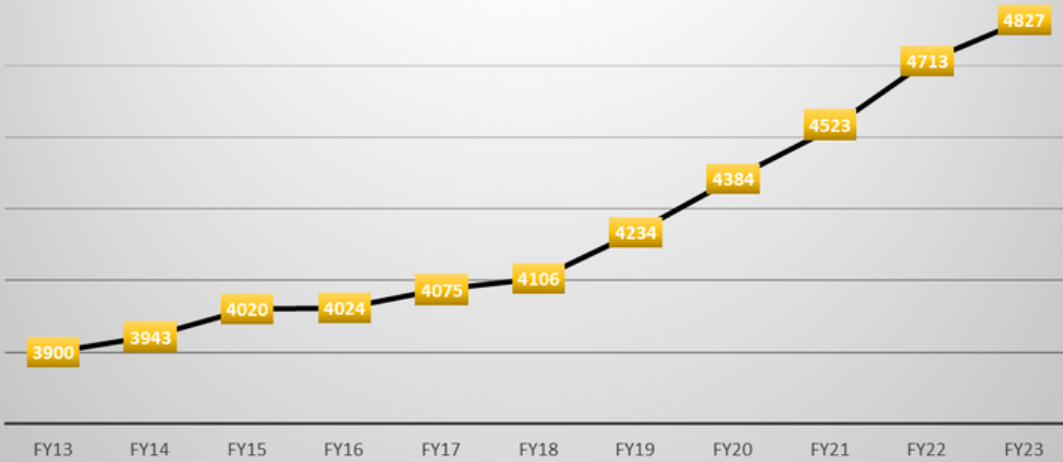

DID YOU KNOW?

THE SWL DISTRICT HAS GROWN BY 927 STUDENTS SINCE THE 2013 SCHOOL YEAR. CURRENT PROJECTIONS HAVE THE DISTRICT GROWING TO 5940 STUDENTS BY THE 2031-2032 SCHOOL YEAR.

When the community approved the bond for new buildings and renovations in the spring of 2017, there were slightly over 4000 students in the District. The 23-24 school year has a current enrollment of 4981 students.



CURRENT AND FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

There are 23 current and future developments in various planning stages within the boundaries of the SWL District. In Etna township alone, this will increase student enrollment by an additional 1099 students, whereas, Kirkersville will see an additional 628 students and Pataskala 612 students. The District, in collaboration with the community, will begin the next phase in planning to accommodate all of the students due to the developments in each township and city.
