

Delphos City School District Hall of Honor

Purpose:

The purpose of the **Delphos City School District Hall of Honor** is to recognize outstanding graduates, former employees of the District and others whose achievements reflect positively upon the District in a significant way. Many potential honorees have earned recognition here at home and many have received high honors or have had distinguished careers far from the Delphos community.

Selection procedures:

The Selection committee and future replacements are recruited and appointed by the Delphos City School District Board of Education or its appointed representative.

Nominations are taken and retained. A maximum of two (2) persons will be selected annually for induction into the **Delphos City Schools Hall of Honor**.

The Selection committee will consider all applications and choose up to two (2) honorees from the field of nominations. There will be two (2) selected per year, unless the Selection Committee determines to honor a different number.

Preference will be given to honoring Alumni of Delphos Jefferson, then employees, and other nominees.

- 1) Alumni: Consideration shall be given to former students who have made significant impact on society.
- 2) Employees: Consideration shall be given to former or current employees, board members, and school volunteers, based on the length and quality of service to the field of education.
- 3) Others: Consideration will be give to those whose achievements reflect positively upon the school in some very significant way.

Recognition:

All honorees will be formally inducted into the **Delphos City School District Hall of Honor** at the Alumni dinner and banquet or other public meeting arranged by the school or this committee.

Procedures for the selection of persons to the **Delphos City School District Hall of Honor** are subject to approval of The Delphos City School District Board of Education. The Board of Education retains the authority to make either temporary or permanent changes in the procedures herein described.
