- Monitoring of systems and structures





 - Grade 8: Only non-accelerated students who do not take Algebra 1 sit for the Math Assessment





What the Data Tells Us:

- o 70% of Grade 10-12 students took at least 1 AP exam
- Total AP enrollment increased to 469 students
- o 79% of PMHS AP students, 371 students, achieved 3+ on their AP exams
- 190 PMHS students are AP Scholars
 - 60 AP scholars
 - 34 AP scholars with Honor
 - 96 AP scholars with Distinction
- PMHS mean scores exceed NY and/or Global Averages for 17 AP exams
- The average score across all AP exams taken by PMHS students in SY 22-23 was
 3.3
- 69% of students in the Class of 2023 received at least one score of 4 or higher on at least one AP exam at any point during high school

What the Data Tells Us:

Dual Enrollment

- o Participation in Dual Enrollment Courses continues to rise.
- 2023-2024: 422+ students with 2 new courses linked for SY 23-24 (Astronomy & Data Science)
- 2022-2023: **391** students
- o 2021-2022: **370** students



In Summary



- State assessment data provides the District with information regarding how students performed on a specific assessment on a specific date
- Information is useful, but limited
 - Useful to inform instruction and curriculum development
 - Progress monitoring of students and programs
 - Informs strategic planning
 - Helpful to MTSS
- Performance report includes summative and performance assessment data
- For progress monitoring, formative, real time assessment data and student growth are factors to develop student portfolios
