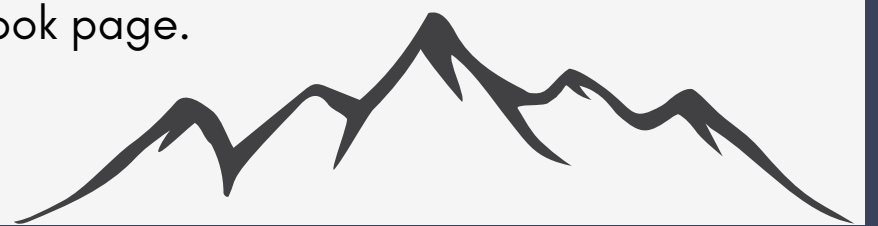
As parents, we will encourage reading and other learning experiences at home. We will attend STREAM Night as well parent-teacher conferences.
