Synopses of meetings of the Board of Trustees of School District Five of Lexington and Richland Counties are provided for your information by Lexington-Richland Five's Office of Community Services.

April 26, 2010

At the April 26, 2010 school board meeting, the following took place:

- The Board of Trustees recognized three school staffs for their increase in fundraising and percent of staff contributions to the United Way of the Midlands. The schools were Harbison West Elementary, Chapin Middle and Irmo High.
- The school board meeting schedule for the 2010-11 school year was approved. It is available online.
- The Student Code of Conduct (board policies JICDA-R and JICDA) was approved.
- The school board discussed the 2010-11 General Fund Budget. The proposed budget totals \$141,447,683, which is less than the 2009-10 budget. In fact, the funding level per student is at 1995 levels. Over the past three years, Lexington-Richland Five has been cut approximately \$15 million.
- The board discussed a request from the Richland County Sheriff's Department to use CrossRoads Middle School in July for a Character Camp and a request from Ashland United Methodist Church to use Irmo High School for a Sackahatchie Camp.

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the school board will be held on Monday, May 10 at 7 p.m. at CrossRoads Middle School.
