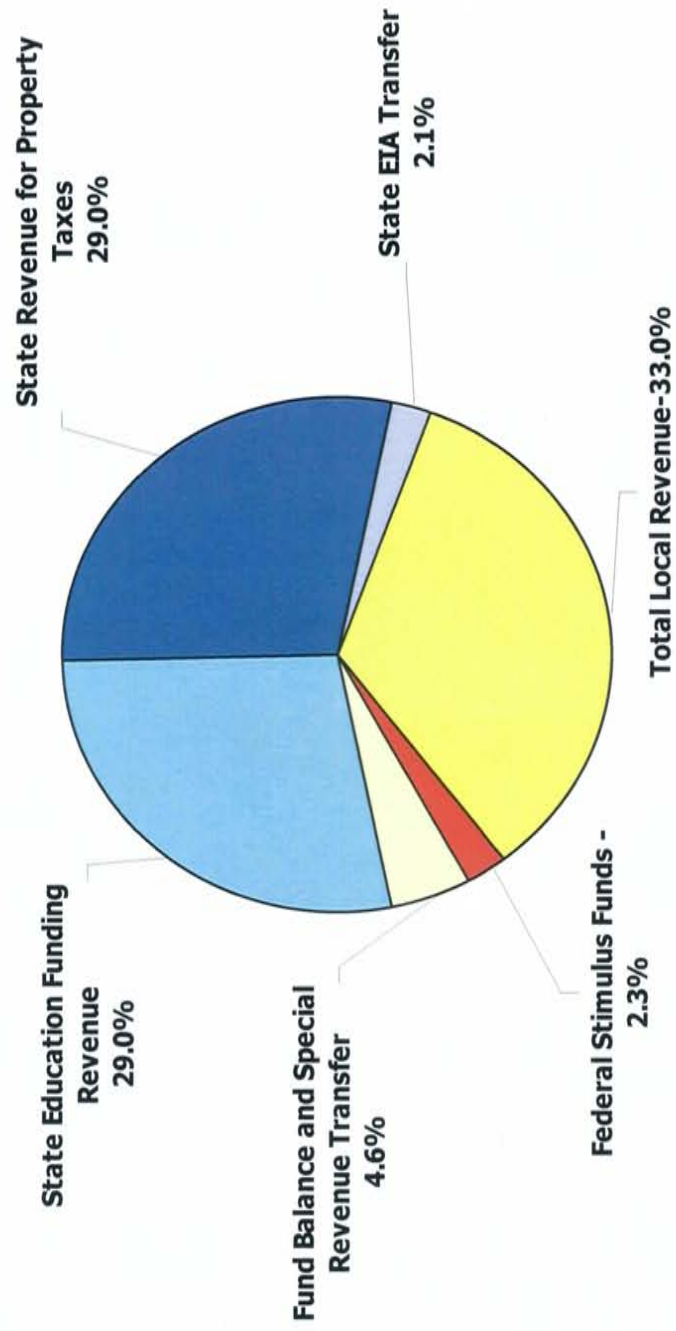

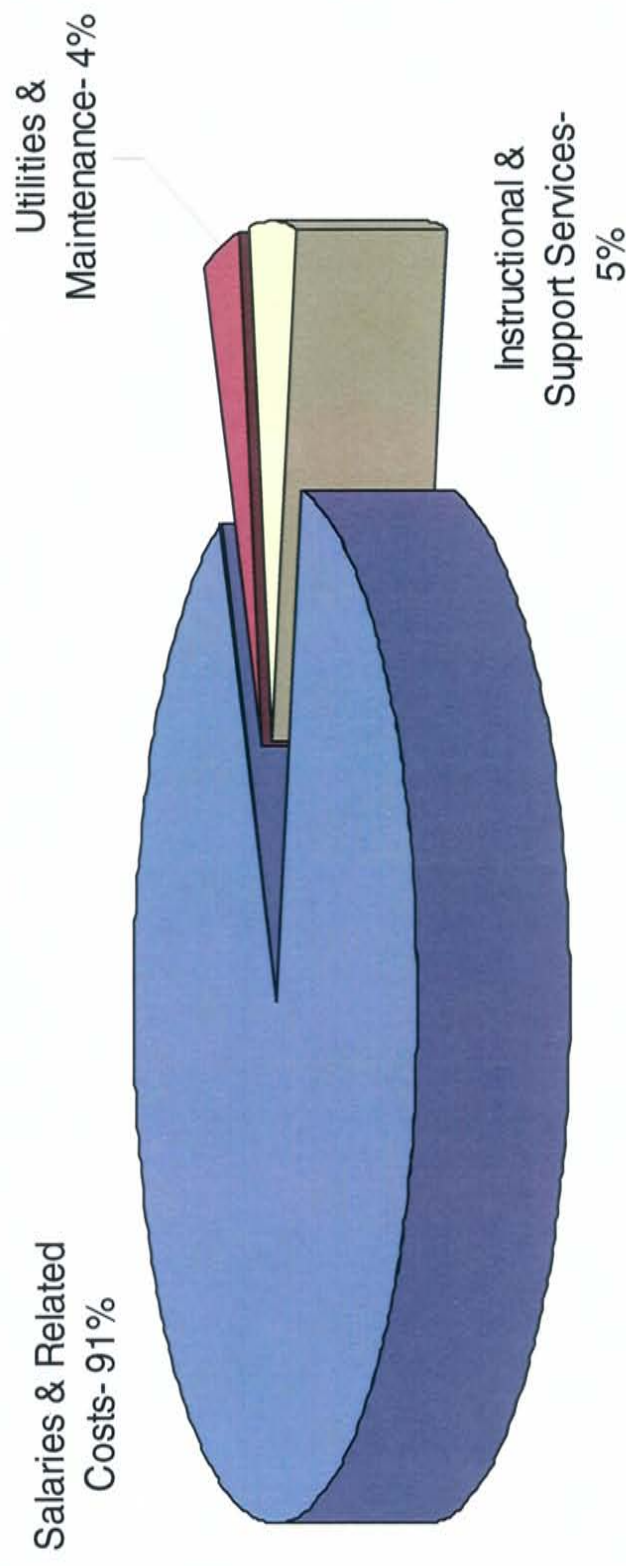
Anticipated General Fund Revenue

Use of Fund Balance

- When used for recurring expenditures, a replacement of revenue must be found.
- Unless replaced with other revenue, the amount of fund balance used will double each year.
- To comply with policy and to maintain the district's bond rating, the district needs to maintain a fund balance equal to at least 8.5% of the operating budget which is approximately \$12.1 million.

State Revenue

- Since 2006-2007 state revenue collections have decreased approximately \$1.6 billion.
- No growth in revenue is projected until 2012.
- Beyond 2012 revenue growth is expected to average not more than 2% per year.
- The decline in revenue since 2006-2007 has been in excess of 23%.
- District Five has been cut approximately \$16,000,000 in state revenue since 2007-2008.

Local Revenue

- Act 388 limits the Board's ability to increase millage.

- Projected recurring costs for the new high school and CATE center is approximately \$2.2 million.
- Projected recurring costs for the new elementary school is approximately \$800,000.

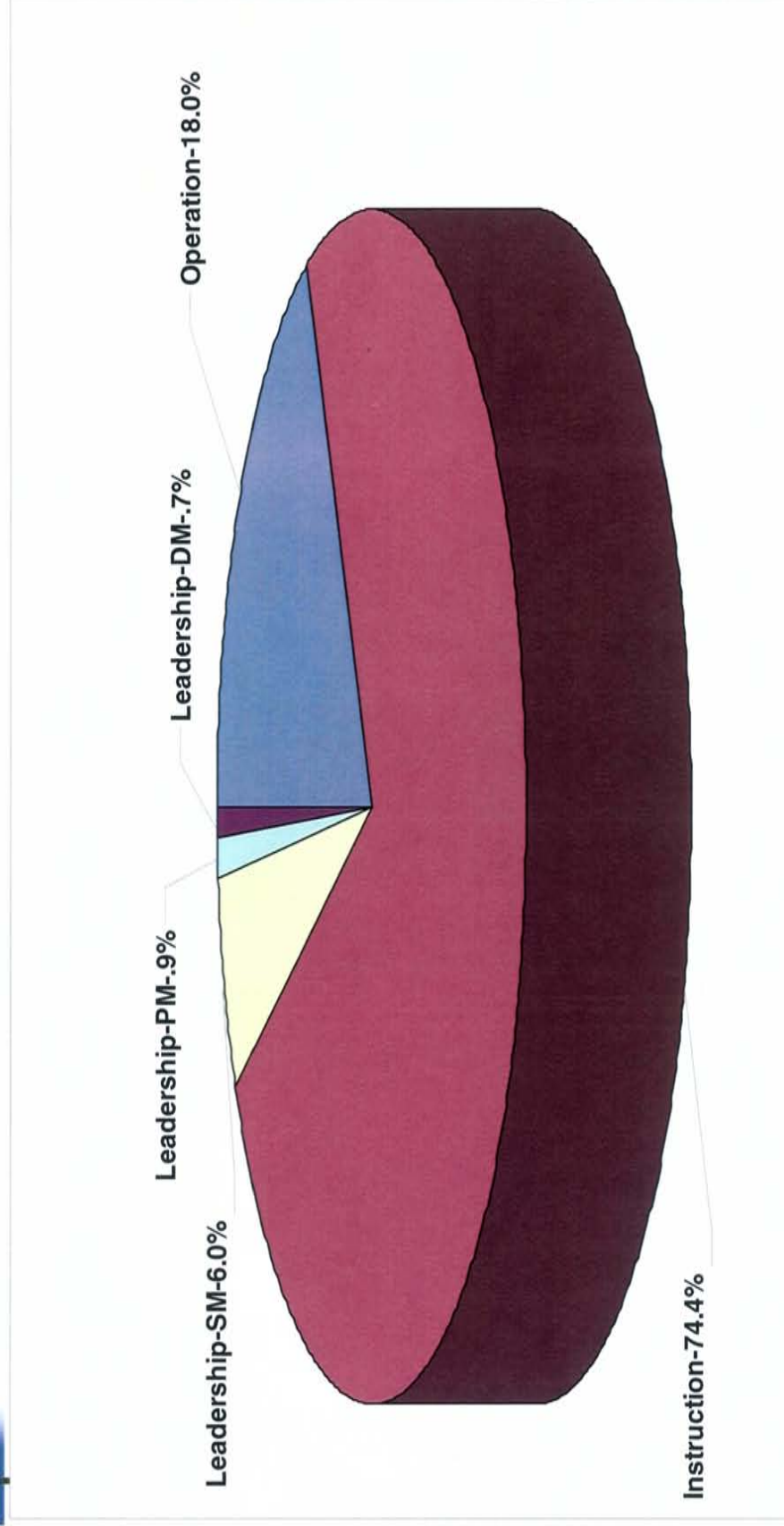
