Synopses of meetings of the Board of Trustees of School District Five of Lexington and Richland Counties are provided for your information by the Office of Community Services.

September 27, 2010

At the September 27, 2010 school board meeting, the following took place:

- The school board named [Dr. Stephen Hefner](#) interim superintendent, effective January 1, 2011. Hefner retired from Richland School District Two in June 2010.
- The board approved construction documents for the new high school and Career and Technical Education Center. The projects will now go to bid, with a scheduled completion date of July 2012.
- The board approved board policies GBAA “Sexual Discrimination and Harassment,” GBAA-R “Administrative Rule,” JI “Student Rights and Responsibilities,” JI-R “Administrative Rule,” and GBEBDA “Criminal Records Checks.”
- Approval was given to Refuge Church to use Lake Murray Elementary and to D.A.Y. to use Seven Oaks Elementary.
- The board discussed the [proposed 2011-12 district calendar](#). Input is currently being sought and the board will revisit the calendar at their December 13 meeting.
- The board discussed revisions to policies JIC “Student Conduct,” JK “Student Discipline,” JKB “Detention of Students,” JKD “Suspension of Students,” JKD-R “Administrative Rule,” JKD-E “Suspension Instructions,” JKE “Expulsion of Students,” JKE-R “Expulsion of Students” and JKE-E “Expulsion Instructions.”

The next regularly scheduled meeting of the school board will be Monday, October 11 at 7 p.m. at the H. E. Corley Elementary. The public is invited and encouraged to attend.
