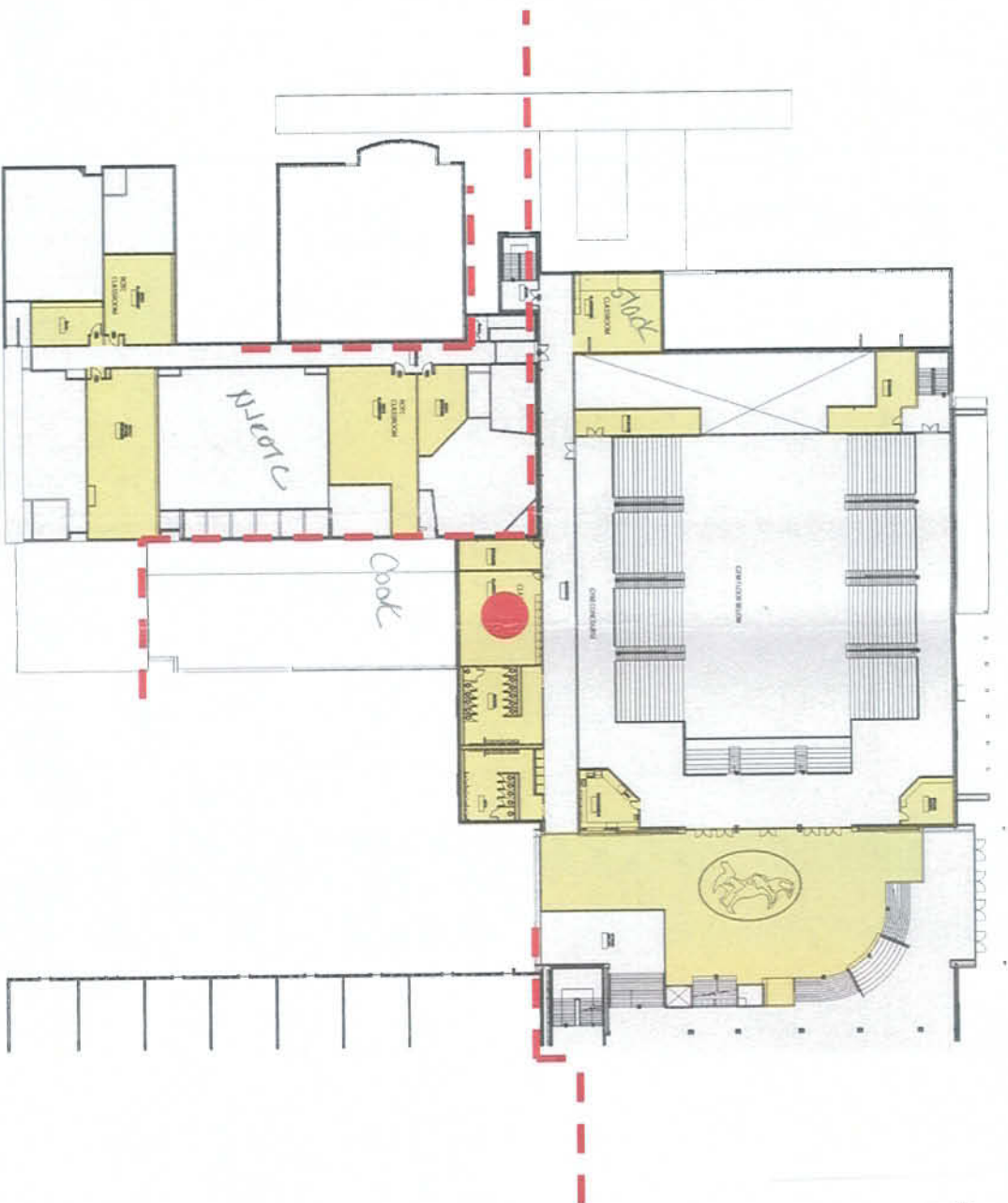

I want to piggy back on what Mr. Turner said about having adequate time to review the method of financing and this discussion. I apologize in advance – I have not had the opportunity to run this by my fellow board members and I hope you will second the motion for the purpose of discussion.

I feel sometimes feel that my motions don't get seconded or approved because it's me making them. So again, I would appreciate a second of this motion:

*I move that we continue the discussion but defer the vote on this matter and remand it back to the superintendent to submit the projects for review, which has not yet been done per our Board Policy FB, to the Capital Improvements Committee and then, as stated in the policy, provide the Board with:*

- 1. A complete description of the proposed projects.*
- 2. A statement of justification for the projects.*
- 3. The estimated total cost of the projects.*
- 4. An estimate of any future annual operating costs associated with the project.*
- 5. A proposed plan of financing the project.*

*And, in conjunction with the Committee's review of those proposed projects and the proposed reallocation of bond referendum monies, which were originally designated for a new middle school, or other bond referendum monies or eight-percent monies proposed to fund them, this motion is to include the examination of space needs at Chapin Middle School by the Committee and the presentation of options to address those needs and, in addition, the examination of the construction of the auditorium that was part of the Chapin High School Master Plan presented during the successful referendum campaign, which has since been removed.*

I am proposing this for several reasons:

1. Number one, it's our policy and it's the fiscally responsible thing to do. Prior to approving the proposed projects, the board and the public need to be provided with the bullets I listed previously that are noted in that policy. I need this so I can make an informed decision, as well.

2. The referendum had incorporated a new middle school and funding of that school now is proposed to be reallocated. Presently, Chapin Middle is over-capacity. It has already had one expansion and currently has 8 portables. It will likely need another portable to address next year's enrollment. I'm not saying the only way to solve the overcrowding is to build a new school, however, prior to obligating funding for these two projects (IHS and DFH) or future projects that was to relieve overcrowding at this school to other projects that weren't part of the referendum - options need to be presented to us on how we're going to deal with the situation at Chapin Middle School. I'm not saying I'm not saying I'm opposed to the two projects but they weren't part of the referendum. The middle school was.
3. The referendum had incorporated academic renovations and athletic renovations and Fine Arts renovations at Chapin High. Though I emphatically believe and can prove that Chapin High is not being expanded to the capacity promised in the referendum and several components have been removed from the plan, the Master Plan included a new academic wing, new ball fields, a small field house, a new gym and an auditorium. On the Master Plan, the 2,300 square foot field house and the auditorium were labeled as "future." However, after the referendum, the auditorium was removed from the Master Plan and the field house was expanded to 10,000 square feet and became part of the current project.
4. I have seen first-hand the benefits to the students of fine arts as a part of the curriculum. I have children who have participated and are currently participating in the programs. In fact, one of my daughters is a voice major at Clemson. I also have two athletes so I respect and appreciate the athletic program.

I am not recommending for or against the proposed projects at Irmo and Dutch Fork High that are up for a vote tonight, but I believe we need to see all our needs, the funding that is available, and a list of how they are to be prioritized. We also need to see the status of our existing construction projects and the funding that will be required to complete those before we commit to more projects.

I'm not proposing how to fund these two items... an option of addressing overcrowding at Chapin Middle and an auditorium at Chapin, however, I have some ideas:

Regarding the auditorium... In the revised plan for Chapin High School, after the auditorium was removed, a stage and related components are being designed inside the new arena-style gym. However, in order for this to occur, the locker rooms are

to be removed from the proposed gym and relocated inside the 10,000 field house that was not originally included on the referendum plans.

There is no amount of money that can make a gym sound like an auditorium or anything close. In fact, voices are almost inaudible and sound is terribly distorted.

I would propose that instead of quadrupling the size of the field house, the locker rooms could be relocated back to their original location inside the gym, and the stage and various components could be removed from the gym. Funding made available from the removal of stage and components could then be utilized towards an appropriate auditorium facility.

In addition, in our board packet, a letter from the administration states that there is an additional \$1.7 million from this year's budget that has not been allocated. I would suggest that as potential funding.

Also, the district has collected over \$24 million in Fund Balance, though I disagree with how it came to be, that money is a source.

(The board chairman cut off my discussion at this point and the paragraph below, which was to be part of my discussion and recorded comments, was never verbalized.)

The Board serves as trustee of school facilities and overseer of school business and we are to govern in accordance with board policies. To that end, Policy FB was developed to help the board effectively and efficiently manage resources made available through taxpayer funds. I ask that you support my motion and follow board policy.

Mr. Gantt,

It is my opinion that the secretary, who is charged with preparing an accurate account of our board meetings, has some level of responsibility to assist board members with "for the record" statements or documents. Rightly so, and it was appreciated, Ms. Stowers informed me of two occasions during the March 12th meeting that I requested my statements go on the record.

So that there would be an accurate account of the meeting, as you can see from the email chain, I requested more information about those two statements. I requested the information so that I could transcribe the statements from the audio tape without listening to the entire 2-3 hour tape. (Ms. Stowers has assisted other board members with their statements.)

Since Ms. Stowers was aware that I requested the two statements go on the record, as she noted, I would think that it would be possible for her to identify other information so that I could more easily locate the statements on the tape. It is possible that she had no other information or was it that she was directed not to provide it to me? Because I did not hear back from her, I feel it was the latter.

Though I disagree that board members should have the responsibility of preparing their statements because I have seen that board members have "re-written" what they actually stated and that I believe it should be the responsibility of Ms. Stowers or whomever is creating the official account of our meetings to do that, if board members are to be charged with it, then I believe we should have a system so that they can assist us. It could be as simple as noting the agenda item that was being discussed when the "for the record statement" was made or at what point documents were requested go on the record.

I have not reviewed the minutes of the meeting to see if you have placed in them the one statement that I was able to locate. I have received no information in regard to the second, however, I would appreciate receiving it and that it too be recorded in the minutes of the March 12th board meeting.

I am copying the entire Board in an effort to clarify this process for everyone. Minutes should be an Executive summary of actions taken by the Board. Motions need to reflect actions desired not rhetorical political statements of a position by any one Board member. Monday's meeting goal is to cover the complete Agenda. To do that, it will take staying on task, on time and adhering to Board parameters for the conduct of our meetings.
