Synopses of meetings of the Board of Trustees of School District Five of Lexington and Richland Counties are provided for your information by the Office of Community Services.

August 13, 2012

At the August 13, 2012 school board meeting, the following took place:

- An update on the cost of the lawsuit brought by Kim Murphy, *Murphy vs. School District Five of Lexington and Richland Counties and DHEC*, was provided. As of August 13, 2012, the estimated cost of the lawsuit exceeds \$12.5 million.
- A report on [ratings received by district schools](#) under South Carolina's new accountability system was provided. The school district received an "A" rating.
- The school board approved a resolution authorizing the issuance and sale of not exceeding \$115,655,000 in general obligation bonds.
- Information was provided regarding the [new main entrance of Irmo High School](#).
- The board reappointed Roger Banta to the Richland County Board of Assessment Appeals.
