At the October 22, 2012 school board meeting, the following took place:

- Information concerning the Gifted and Talented Program was provided by Coordinator Tami Richardson.
 - A video describing Gifted and Talented programs was provided for the board and community.
- Information concerning new design and construction was provided by Director Keith McAlister.
- Students who have artwork on display at the District Office were recognized, as well as three district-level winners. In addition, the board recognized National Merit and National Achievement semi-finalists and the finalists for District Teacher of the Year as well as District Teacher of the Year Ashley Metz.
- The board approved the bid for Phase I renovations and additions to Dutch Fork High School. The bid was awarded to the lowest, responsible, responsive bidder.
