Project Description:

Construct a new classroom addition and bring the student capacity to 1,700 students. Construct new gymnasium with stage. Expand the cafeteria and media center. Site upgrades to include new practice fields and an end zone athletic facility. Improve parking and traffic flow.

Status:


- Steel bar joists, decking, brick and overhead rough-in are complete in the strings area.
- The footings for the computer lab area are in progress.
- Steel bar joists are being set at the new gym and second floor classrooms adjacent to the gym.
- The roof is dried in on the Field House and the Handicapped access ramp is being poured.
- The brick columns are being laid and the concrete slabs for the exterior plaza area are being poured.
- The connector ramp from the cafeteria to 'H' has the footings poured and walls are in progress.
- The ceilings, HVAC, lights and ceiling tile is being installed on both floors of the classrooms of area 'H'.
- The terrazzo installation and the logos for the office area 'l' are complete. Vinyl base installation is in progress in the 'l' corridors.
- The grassing is complete at the practice football and soccer fields and is growing extremely well.
- The site retaining wall at the practice soccer field is complete and the wall is near completion at the practice football field.
- The exterior metal buildings at the practice fields are in progress.
- Curbing, grading and stone for the rear driveways is in progress to be ready for paving.

Achievements/Key Issues:

- The capital renewal accomplished as part of this project includes: clock system, fire alarm, hardware systems, HVAC, PA/intercom, roofing and interior finishes.
- A follow-up meeting has been held with the brick manufacturer and they fully intend to correct any discoloration issues. They will be staining the worst area of discolored brick in the next few weeks. Before and after photos will be taken and shared with the Board.
- An active catch basin that was covered up as part of the 1999 Media Center expansion has been discovered and has resulted in flooding of the media center. We have corrected the issue.

Schedule/Budget Issues:

- Due to continuous delays, the final completion date of the project will be December 2014.
- A wet winter, spring and summer has impacted the project schedule. Project Team is working to make up time wherever possible.

Status:


- Ceiling tile is being installed in all areas of the building.
- Kitchen Equipment and Serving Lines are in place in the Kitchen Area and DHEC has inspected the space.
- The basketball goals, scoreboards, wood flooring and bleachers are installed in the main gym. Striping and sealing are in progress.
- The Multi-Purpose Room seating installation is in progress.
- The Elevator has been installed and has passed inspection.
- Nu Idea has been installing office furniture, media center furniture and classroom furniture during the 1st week of August.
- Exterior sidewalks, paving and canopies around the high school are near completion.
- Irrigation, topsoil and fine grading are in progress around the high school.
- OSF Final Inspections occurred on August 1st, 2nd and 7th.

Achievements/Key Issues:

• The City of Columbia redefined the first phase of the City Capital Improvement Project to run the 24" water line from the Waterfall Subdivision to the CATE Center.

Schedule/Budget Issues:

Status:


- Health Science masonry approaching completion at second of 3 levels and MEP rough in continues.

- Building wall placement, foundations and underground rough in is ongoing at the Auditorium.
- Stadium upgrades are ongoing.

The OSF Final Inspection at CATE 1 and CATE 2 passed successfully.

Schedule/Budget Issues:

- Project was delayed due to unforeseen site conditions. This includes a large debris pile that was buried at the Auditorium area.
