*The purpose of the middle school World Languages Program in District Five is to provide a progression of language experiences.*

- **6th grade students: 9-week course “Welcome to World Languages”**
  - **7th grade students: May take a semester “Prep” class**
  - **8th grade students: May take the year-long Level 1 course of a World Language for Carnegie Credit.**

**For any student planning to attend a four-year college or university to have at least two (2) units of the same World Language for admission.**
