- There are three primary indicators for the state's new accountability model.
 - Academic Indicators
 - School Quality Indicators
 - Student Success Indicators
- The rating formula for each school is determined by the school's grade levels and number of English Learners.
- Schools will receive ratings in each measured area as well as an overall summative rating.
