- Developed by the South Carolina Department of Education and educators from across the state
- New rubric designed to assess a teacher's professional practice
- Timeline:
 - 2016-2017 - Training of District Administrators
 - 2017-2018 - Continued district training and support on transition to rubric
 - 2018- 2019 - Full statewide implementation
