Irmo High School Sting Deli



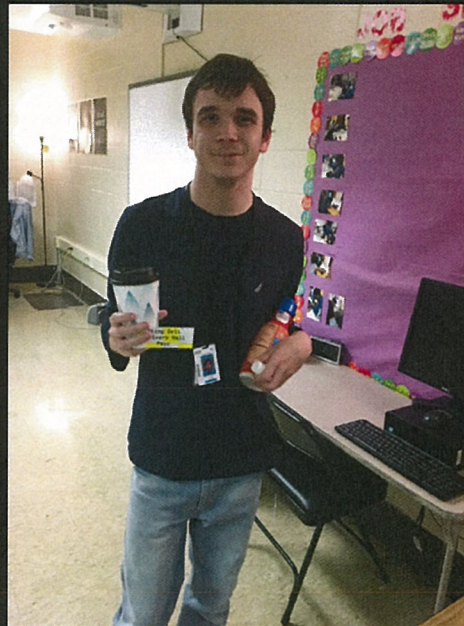
- Student-run for 22 years

- Ordering is a holiday tradition for faculty and community members.

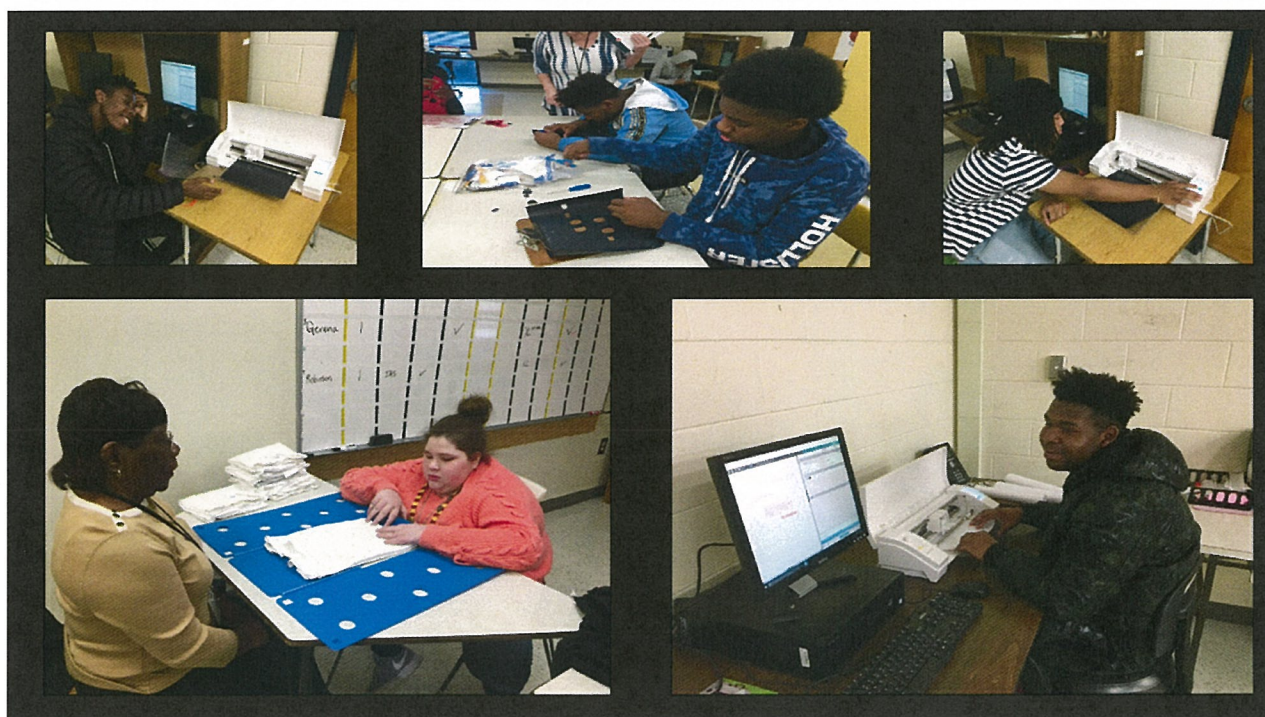

Dutch Fork High School



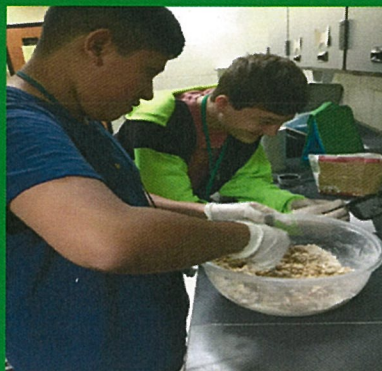
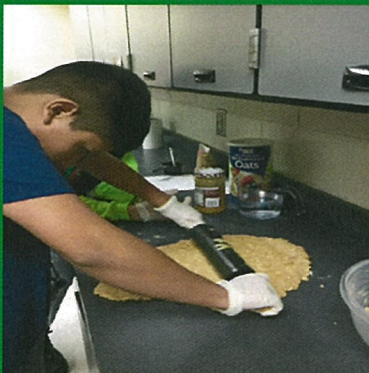
Foxy Dog Treats

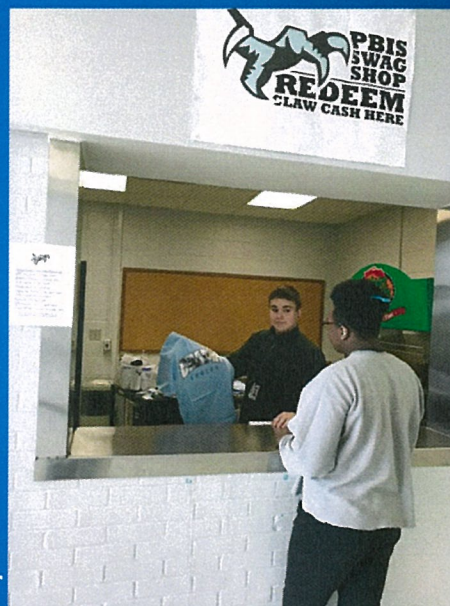


Chapin High School
